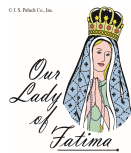

The **Statue of Our Lady Of Fatima** will be the home of Sherry Zimmerman until October 6th.

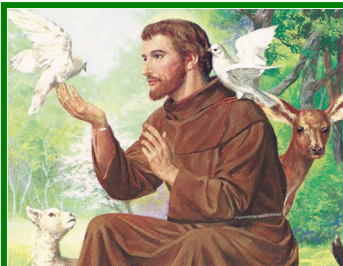

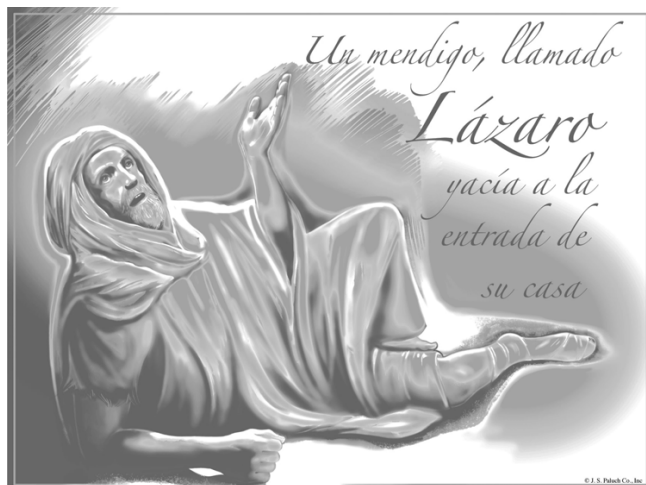

Over the weekend, the parish office and a some of the ministry leaders at St. Francis of Assisi in Yuma received telephone calls claiming to be from a priest in Mexico who said he was in an office with Fr. Emilio Chapa. The message said something like: "Hi, I am here with Fr. Chapa and I need you to get an envelope full of money from Fr. Chapa's office and send it to me as soon as possible." Fortunately, the office staff was suspicious, contacted Fr. Chapa and confirmed it was a scam.

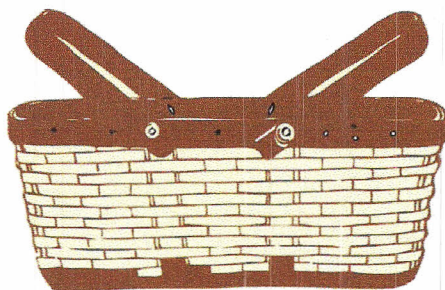
**Our Lady of the Mountains – St. Vincent de Paul Conference

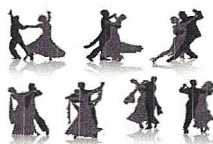

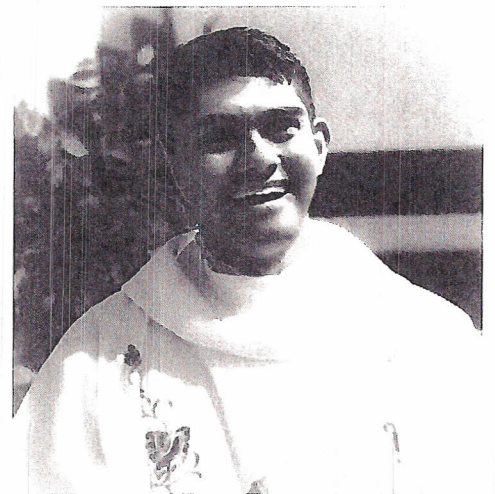

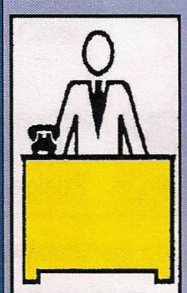
