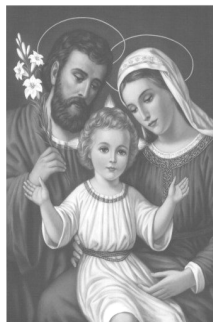

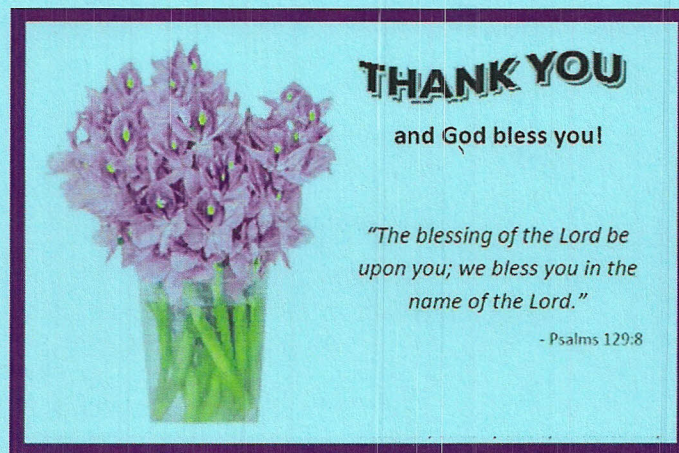


To our OLM Parish Family:
