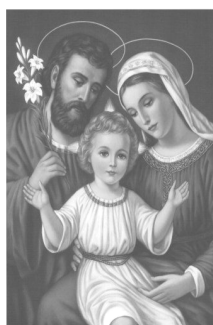

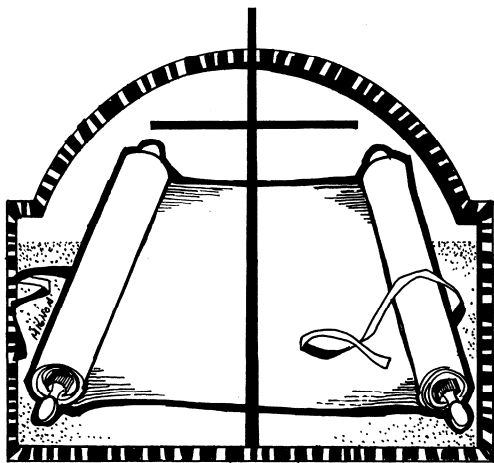

## Lenten Observance and Soup Night

Dear OLM Family,

As Lent approaches we would like to call to mind the annual Stations of the Cross and soup night here at OLM. The tradition has been handed over from our AVE Ministry to Our St. Vincent de Paul ~ OLM Conference. We, Vincentians are blessed to be entrusted with this tradition and thank AVE for its many years of dedication to provide the Lenten Meal.

As we move into a new beginning you will see some changes in the presentation and process of soup night. Our OLM Conference Vincentians will provide the simple meal of soup and bread to all who come after Stations of the Cross to share the season with fellowship as a church community. A goodwill offering will be taken. All proceeds will go to St. Vincent DePaul to aid in our mission of feeding the poor.

"Even by the time of Christ, fasting and abstaining were venerable traditions of piety among the Jews. The practices were not foreign to Christ (Matthew 6:16 Mark 2:20, 9:29) or the apostles (Acts 13:2, 14:23). In the early Church, a two or three day Lenten fast was common. It was not until the fourth century and the Council of Nicea that a forty day period was mentioned. In the Middle Ages the rule relaxed somewhat, with a light second meal and fish allowed. From time to time and place to place, there has been variation in practice, but consistency of spirit: the life of a Christian is a life of penance." (Catholic Source Book)

The Code of Canon Law: #1249f tells us:

- The season of Lent preserves its penitential character.
- The days of penance are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent.
- The manner of fulfilling the precept of penance:
  - Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.
  - All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence only.
- Church law binds as follows:
  - The law of abstinence (not eating meat) obliges those who have completed their fourteenth year.
  - The law of fast (only one full meal each day, nothing between meals) obliges those who have completed their eighteenth year until the beginning of their sixtieth year.
  - Proportionately grave inconvenience excuses from the laws of fast and abstinence.
- The substantial observance of these laws is a grave obligation.
  - Anyone who neglects all forms of penance violates divine law and is guilty of grave sin.
  - Anyone who occasionally violates the law of fast and/or abstinence is not guilty of sin.

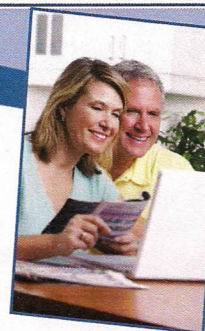

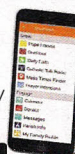
