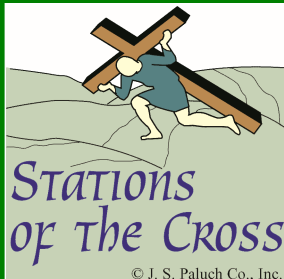

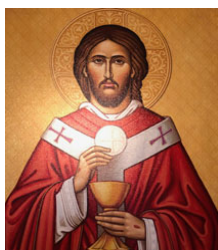

We start with ashes, MY ashes –a reminder that I am in need of saving from the death that awaits me. I need a savior.

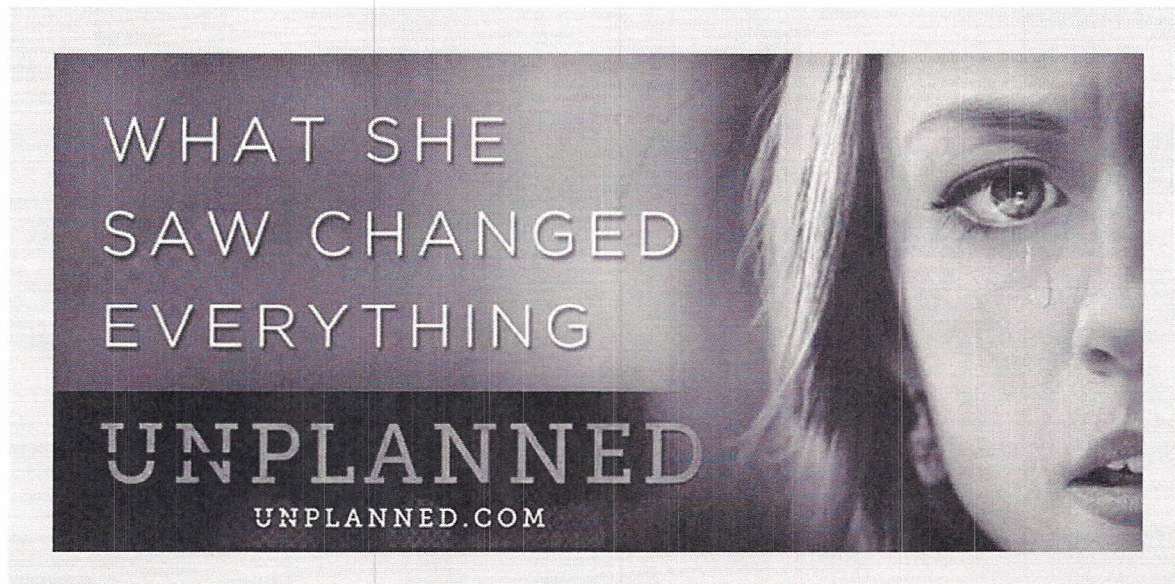

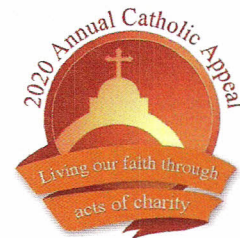

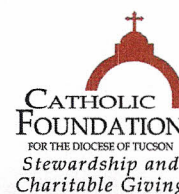
