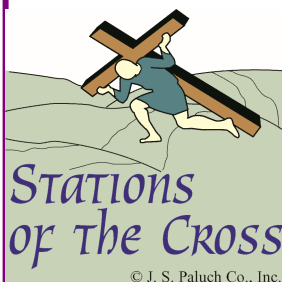

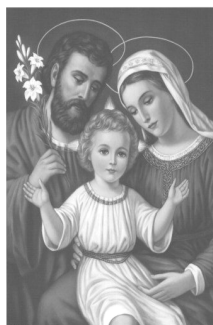

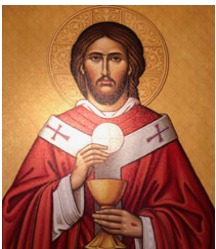
RCIA Corner
