A Quick Questions and Answers Guide to Arizona Tuition Tax Credits

Q. Can I benefit from giving to CTSO?

A1. Yes, you benefit if you have AZ tax liability.

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): \$1,250 Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,089

Your new tax payment due to AZ is now only: \$161

A2. You benefit even if you get a refund.

Your AZ tax withholding: \$1,500
Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): -\$1,250
Your AZ tax refund (what you overpaid): \$250
Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,089

Your new AZ tax refund increases to: \$1,339

Examples assume single taxpayer with at least \$1,250 of AZ tax liability.

School Tuition Organizations cannot award, restrict or reserve scholarships solely based on a donor's recommendation. CARDIOVASCULAR SCREENINGS

HEART ULTRASOUND

Screening visualizes the heart valves, measures systolic function, the motility of the left ventricle, ejection fraction and dimensions of the atrium and ventricles.




