**SAINT CHARLES LWANGA AND HIS COMPANIONS  
(martyred 1886-87)  
June 3**

"Master of Pages," reputedly the handsomest man in all Uganda, Charles Lwanga, lay catechist, courageously led about forty teenaged boys, Catholics and Anglicans, on a forty-mile forced march to martyrdom for their common Christian faith. Teaching each other the hymns of their different churches, they strengthened one another for the ordeal ahead. King Mwanga, himself barely twenty, had ordered them executed for being "those who pray." But these royal pages were the king's male harem, who, now Christians, refused what pious accounts demurely describe as his "unreasonable demands." Some were clubbed to death, most burned alive; the youngest, thirteen-year old Saint Kizito, whom Charles had often shielded from the King's lust; the most tragic, Saint Mbagha, whose father was his executioner! In 1964, Paul VI canonized the young Catholics and praised their Anglican companions, recalling the heroism of early Christianity's African martyrs, which we modern Christians of far less faith never expected to see repeated. Forty years after the pope's words, what does our faith cost us? Heroism aside, how generous is our response?

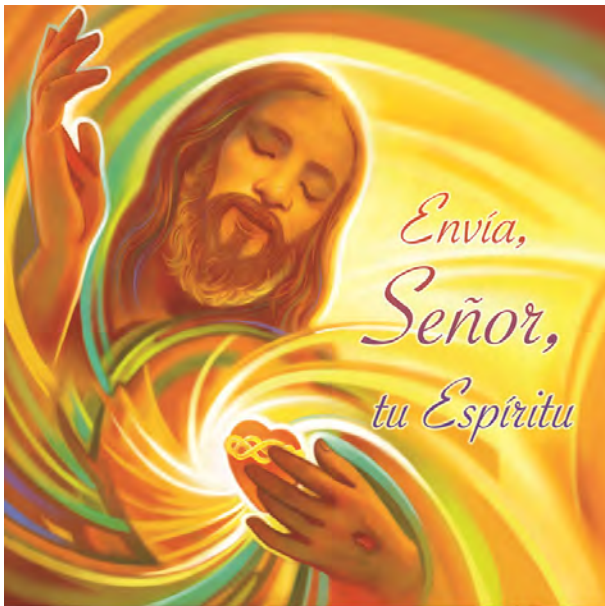

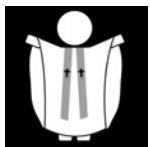

## WELCOME FR. MIKE MARTINEZ

Fr Mike Martinez is a priest of the Diocese of Tucson. A native of Arizona, he was born in Safford in 1963. He and his family moved to Morenci, Arizona in 1974. After graduating from Morenci High School in 1981 he attended College Seminary at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio and graduated in 1985 with a B. A. in Latin American Studies. He then attended graduate school at St. John's School of Theology in Camarillo, California and graduated in 1989 with a Masters of Divinity in Theology. He was ordained to the priesthood in June of 1989. He has served the Diocese of Tucson for 29 years at Our Mother of Sorrows, Tucson, St. Andrew's, Sierra Vista, St. Odilia's, Tucson, St. Monica's, Tucson, Chaplain at the Arizona State Penitentiary, Florence, St. Ambrose, Tucson, and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton's, Tucson.

From 1999-present Fr. Mike has been a Chaplain for the Arizona Air National Guard as a traditional/reservist guardsman. Since 2006-present he has been on active duty orders serving the 162d Wing in Tucson. He has deployed to and been in Egypt, Qatar, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia and flew on aero-medivac missions to help retrieve wounded military members in the Iraq cities of Bagdad, Balad, Tallil, and Tikrit. He retired from military service.

He enjoys studying and preaching the truths found in the Sacred Scriptures and Moral Theology. When not serving in ministry he is an avid outdoorsman and can be found fishing or hunting somewhere. He is an accomplished musician/bass player and plays and composes music in the jazz-fusion genre.

Chaplain, Lt Col Michael A. Martinez is the Wing Chaplain at the 162d Wing, Arizona Air National Guard, Tucson, Arizona. As the Wing Chaplain he advises the Wing Commander and leadership on moral and ethical issues, the free exercise of religion, and religious accommodation. He helps to ensure that the 1,600 military members receive proper pastoral care. The wing consists of three F-16 flying squadrons and provides maintenance support for the Air National Guard/Air Force Reserve Command Test Center. His pastoral reach includes the airmen serving at the 214th Reconnaissance Group, Operation Snowbird and the Aerospace Control Alert, located at Davis-Monthan Air Force Base, Tucson, Arizona.

Chaplain Martinez is a native of Safford, Arizona and entered the Arizona Air National Guard in 1999 as a Chaplain. He is a Roman Catholic priest for the Diocese of Tucson, Arizona.
