



SAINT JOHN FISHER (1469-1535) AND SAINT THOMAS MORE (1477-1535) June 22

From Robert Bolt's classic A Man for All Seasons to Showtime's edgy The Tudors, Thomas More endears himself still: lawyer-statesman of impeccable integrity, remarried widower and affectionate father delighting in a lively household—four children, a pet monkey, even a paid jester! And challenges still: humanist-reformer, yet champion of Catholic faith and papal primacy. John Paul II named him Patron of Statesmen and Politicians, citing More's generous work, both as a lawyer and in government service, on behalf of the poorest and most marginalized people of his time, as well as his promotion of education for all sectors of society. More's decision for principle over politics, conscience over convenience prompted his final words: "I die the king's good servant, but God's first." Alone among England's bishops, John Fisher dared challenge Henry VIII's divorce and repudiation of the papacy. When the Pope named the imprisoned Fisher a cardinal, Henry thundered: "Don't bother sending Fisher's red hat here; I'll send Fisher's head to Rome!" Whose "good servants" are we first? Isn't a right conscience worth the pain of standing alone?







Dear Brothers and Sisters,

After a month of drive-in masses, we are in for a change. Weekend masses will move inside our church building **beginning Saturday**, **July 4**. In order to do this, we need to make some adaptations. Please read the following carefully. They are the requirements to make our liturgies as safe as we reasonably can. Also, please remember that this is **just another early step** to fully opening our parish church.

Due to the continuing presence of the Covid-19 virus in our community there is an inherent risk, regardless of age or health, in attending any public event. This includes religious services. While we are working to reduce the risk, there are no risk-free situations. A parishioner's presence at a public event constitutes his or her understanding and acceptance of this essential level of risk.

The decision to return to the public celebrations of our faith during this time of pandemic should not be made casually or lightly by anyone.

The Sunday Mass obligation has been suspended indefinitely for all Catholics living in or visiting the Tucson Diocese. No one is required to return to receive Holy Communion or return to in-person Masses at this time.

Those age 65 or older, as well as anyone with a chronic health condition, are strongly urged to remain at home and not come onto church premises. This is a time when such persons should let the church come to them in perhaps a secondary but still meaningful way -- via the internet, television, and other means of technology. (The 10 am live-streamed mass at St. Andrew's will continue indefinitely; other masses are listed on our parish web page.)

Anyone feeling ill in any way is urged, in the strongest sense, to remain at home and

not risk accidental harm to the community gathered at church or other public places.

Public weekend masses will be in the church starting Saturday, July 4.

Here is how we will accomplish this:

We return to our original Mass schedule:

Saturday Vigil Mass at 5:00 pm

Sunday morning: 7:30 am; 9:30 am and 11:30 am (Spanish)

Sunday evening: 5:00 pm

Please note that the church courtyard restrooms will be open but the drinking fountains will not be available. If needed, please bring your own water and take the bottle home with you. Please bring face masks and hand sanitizer with you. Your wearing of masks helps protect the priests and ministers, so for all over the age of 2, please show your support by wearing a mask during the entire liturgy except when consuming the Holy Eucharist.

When you enter the church, ushers will guide you to your seat(s) which are marked off to keep you a safe distance from others. Seating will be every other row.

We have moved some chairs around to maximize our use of space while maintaining a safe distance between persons. Please do not congregate in groups inside or outside the church.

If the church is at safe capacity, please come back for a later mass.

There will be a basket at the church entrance into which you can drop your offering(s). We still strongly recommend you use online giving which is safer for all. You can call the parish office for more information.

For communion you will approach the minister's aisle by aisle maintaining the six foot distance between persons.

Sunday bulletins will not be handed out. We will continue to email them to you. Please keep us up to date with your contact information by calling the parish office at 378-3720 so that we can send you bulletins as well as to inform you of any changes. These instructions are subject to change as circumstances change.

Please continue to pray for our priests and our parish community.

Queridos hermanos,

Después de un mes de misas en el estacionamiento, estamos preparados para un cambio. Las misas de fin de semana se moverán dentro de nuestro edificio de la iglesia a partir del sábado 4 de Julio. Para poder lograr esto, necesitamos hacer algunas adaptaciones. Lea atentamente lo siguiente. Son los requisitos para que nuestras liturgias sean lo más seguras posible. Además, recuerde que este es sólo otro paso a temprana etapa para poder abrir completamente nuestra iglesia parroquial.

Debido a la continua presencia del virus Covid-19 en nuestra comunidad, existe un riesgo inherente, independientemente de su edad o salud, de asistir a cualquier evento público. Esto incluye los servicios religiosos. Mientras trabajamos para reducir el riesgo, no hay situaciones libres de riesgo. La presencia de un feligrés en un evento público constituye su comprensión y aceptación de este nivel esencial de riesgo. La decisión de volver a las celebraciones públicas de nuestra fe durante este tiempo de pandemia no debe ser tomada casual o ligeramente por nadie.

La obligación de la Misa Dominical ha sido suspendida indefinidamente para todos los católicos que viven o visitan la Diócesis de Tucson. Nadie está obligado a regresar para recibir la Santa Comunión o regresar a las Misas en persona en este momento.

Aquellos de 65 años o más, así como cualquier persona con una condición de salud crónica, se les urge encarecidamente a permanecer en casa y no llegar a las instalaciones de la iglesia. Este es un momento en el que esas personas deben dejar que la iglesia se les presente tal vez de una manera secundaria pero todavía significativa -- a través de Internet, la televisión y otros medios de tecnología. (La misa de las 10 am transmitida en vivo en San Andrés, en ingles, se continuará indefinidamente; otras misas se enumeran en nuestra página web parroquial.)

Cualquier persona que se sienta mal de alguna manera se les pide, en el sentido más en fuerte, a permanecer en casa y a no correr el riesgo de sufrir daños accidentales a la comunidad reunida en la iglesia u otros lugares públicos. Las misas públicas de fin de semana estarán en la iglesia a partir del sábado 4 de julio.

Así es como lograremos esto: Volvemos a nuestro horario original de misa: Sábado:

5:00 pm- Ingles

7:30 am- Ingles 9:30 am- Ingles 11:30 am- Español 5:00 pm- Ingles

Tenga en cuenta que los baños de la iglesia estarán abiertos, pero las fuentes no estarán disponibles. Si es necesario, por favor traiga su propia agua y lleve la botella a casa con usted.

Por favor, traiga máscaras faciales y desinfectante de manos con usted. Su uso de máscaras ayuda a proteger a los sacerdotes y ministros, por lo que para todos los mayores. Personas mayores de 2 años, por favor muestre su apoyo usando una máscara durante toda la liturgia, excepto cuando consuma la Santa Eucaristía.

Cuando entres en la iglesia, los ujieres te guiarán a tu(s) asiento(s) que están marcados para mantenerte a una distancia segura de los demás. Se ocuparán los asientos de cada otra fila.

Hemos movido algunas sillas para maximizar nuestro uso del espacio mientras mantenemos una distancia segura entre las personas. Por favor, no se congreguen en grupos dentro o fuera de la iglesia.

Si la iglesia está llena, por favor regrese a una misa de otro horario.

Habrá una canasta en la entrada de la iglesia en la que puede dejar su(s) ofrenda(s). Le recomendamos encarecidamente que utilice la donación en línea que es más seguro para todos. Puede llamar a la oficina parroquial para obtener más información.
