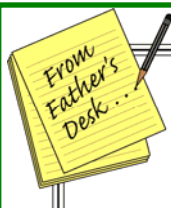
SAINT KATERI TEKAKWITHA (1656-1680)

July 14

Though the New York State Thruway runs close
by the North American Martyrs' Shrine, traffic's roar
never pierces the peace enveloping Auriesville—
Ossernon to Native Americans—in the lovely Mo-
hawk Valley, where Kateri Tekakwitha was born
barely ten years after the martyrdom of Isaac
Jogues and his Jesuit and lay companions. Daugh-
ter of a Christian Algonquin mother and non-
Christian Mohawk chief, Kateri's parents died in a
smallpox epidemic widely blamed on the missionar-
ies. Moreover, many Native Americans had experi-
enced exploitation at the hands of "Christian" traders
and trappers, further discrediting the faith Kateri em-
braced in baptism, then pledged to live even more
intensely in vowed virginity. Misunderstanding led to
harassment, prompting her move to a Christian vil-
lage farther north along the Saint Lawrence River.
Despite this, Kateri's faith remained undaunted, her
selfless charity undiminished. Both before and after
her death at twenty-four, this young "Lily of the Mo-
hawks" drew countless converts to Christ by the fra-
grance of her goodness. Through us, does "the aro-
ma of Christ" (2 Corinthians 2:15), attract others to
the beauty of his gospel?

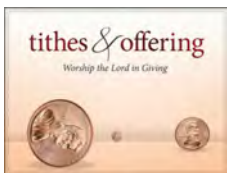

Dear Parishioners,

Starting Sunday July 19, 2020 we will have Holy Communion following each of the live stream Masses. You are invited come to Our Lady of the Mountains Catholic Church and receive Holy Communion at 11am-12 noon and then again at 1pm-2pm. Please note: we will remain past the hour if there are still people in line for communion.

Please enter the parking lot following the normal traffic arrows and come to the Priest/Deacon. We will be stationed under a canopy. You may remain in your car and receive Holy Communion.

The Priest/Deacon will be following protective protocols while distributing Holy Communion. We ask that people wear their masks as the Host is placed in their hands. After saying amen you can remove your mask and receive Holy Communion.

Some may want to watch the Mass on live steam but not come to Church yet. We respect each person's decisions in light of the variables that can affect your vulnerability to the virus. I understand that Church guidance still presently says that due to the pandemic there is no obligation to attend Mass. We are offering Holy Communion in this manner for the time being due to a good number of people requesting it. I continue to be inspired by your faith, devotion, and desire for our Lord present in the Holy Eucharist!!

It is my heartfelt prayer that we will only have to receive Holy Communion in this manner for a very short time. Let us all continue to pray for a speedy return Mass in Church!!!
