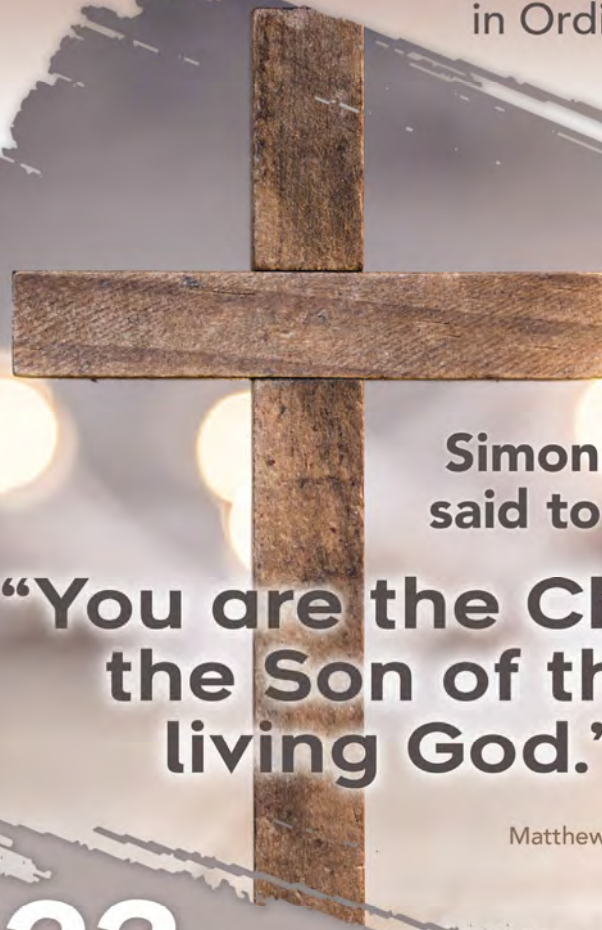

**SAINT MONICA (332-387)
August 27**

She had smiles for the neighbors, though her husband
found her religion and the charity it inspired annoying. She
made tearful prayers in private for a son, outwardly self-assured
but, as his mother knew, inwardly restless, and whose girlfriend
of a dozen years had borne his child out of wedlock. Though not
the first or last such mother and son, Monica and Augustine are
the Church's most famous, so we keep their feast days back to
back, with Monica's, fittingly, first. To Rome she followed Au-
gustine, then to Milan, where years of prayer—and nagging—
finally bore fruit in his conversion by Saint Ambrose. For six
months, mother and son enjoyed the blessing of rediscovering
each other. Just in time! On the way home to North Africa, Mon-
ica took sick and died near Rome. No child who has mourned a
parent can read, unmoved, Augustine's tender account, in his
Confessions, of Monica's last days. At this time of the year,
when parents watch apprehensively as children leave for
school, may Monica's perseverance and Augustine's long-
prayed-for conversion ease anxiety and kindle hope.

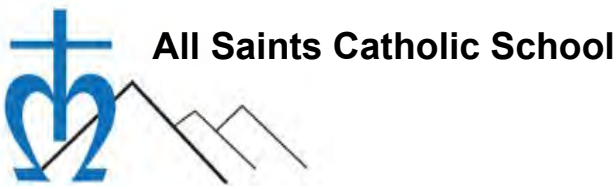
