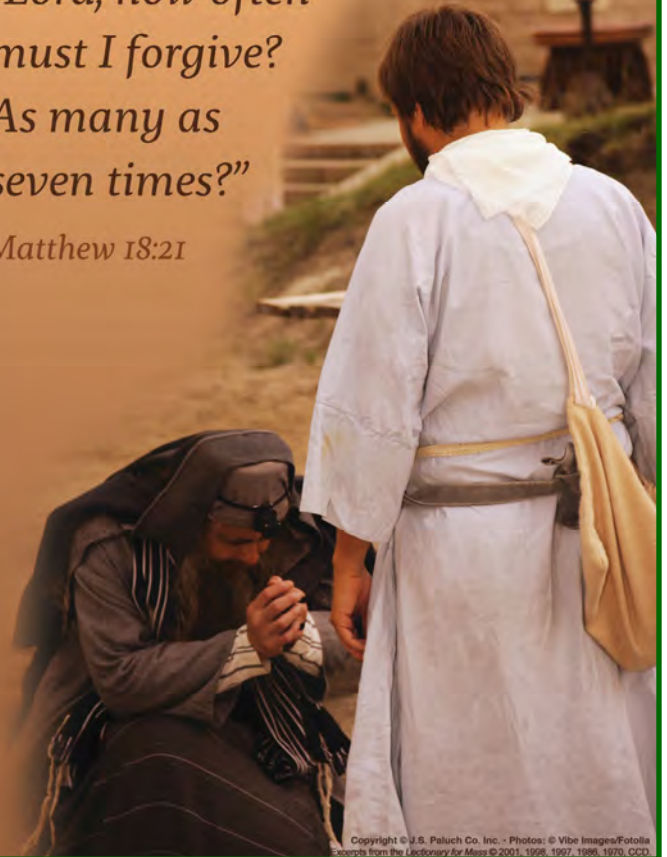

**SAINT ROBERT BELLARME (1542-1652)
September 17**

Born on 4. October 1542 in Montepulciano near Siena,
Robert Bellarmine was the nephew, on his mother's side, of
Pope Marcellus He had an excellent formation in the humanities
before entering the Society of Jesus on 20 September 1560. He
was ordained a priest on 25 March 1570 and was professor of
theology at Louvain. Later, summoned to Rome to teach at the
Roman College, he was entrusted with the chair of apologetics.
Pope Clement VIII created him a cardinal on 3 March 1599 and
on 18 March 1602 he was appointed Archbishop of Capua.
In his last years he composed various books on spirituality in
which he concentrated the results of his annual spiritual exercis-
es. He died in Rome on 17 September 1621. Pope Pius XI be-
atified him in 1923, canonized him in 1930 and proclaimed him
a Doctor of the Church in 1931.
St Bellarmine offers a model of prayer, the soul of every activity:
a prayer that listens to the word of God. He teaches with great
clarity and with the example of his own life that there can be no
true reform of the Church unless there is first our own personal
reform and the conversion of our own heart.

**During this Phase 1 opening of the Church, there will
be no meetings, prayer groups, gatherings, or
receptions at this time. Hopefully as things get better
with the Covid pandemic, we can move forward to the
next phase and be able to be completely back to nor-
mal. We will keep you informed of the latest changes.

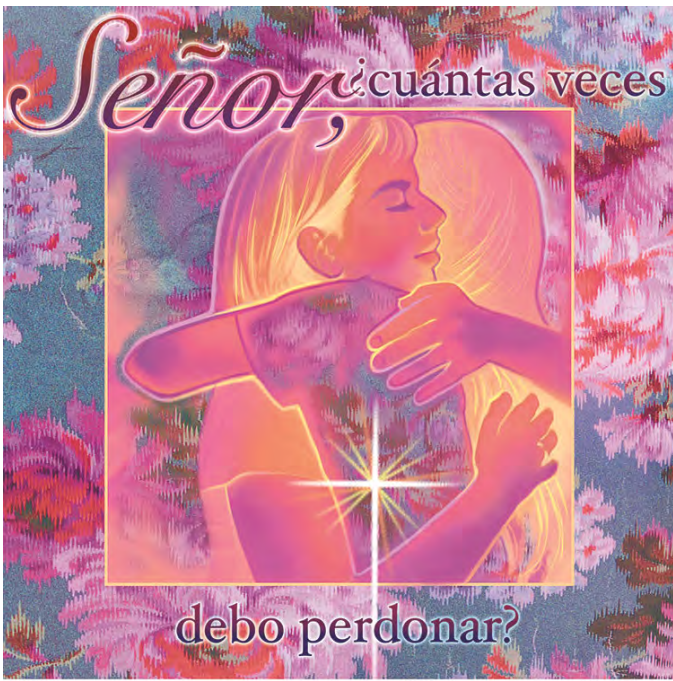

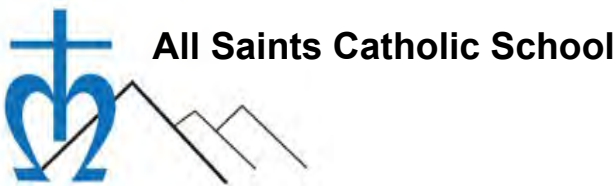
