**FEAST OF FAITH  
The Greeting**

At several points during the liturgy, the presider greets us with the words, "The Lord be with you." These simple words are not like the greetings that we exchange all day long—our "good mornings," our "hellos" and "how are yous." This liturgical greeting has roots deep in the Old Testament. In the book of Ruth, the words "the Lord be with you" are spoken by Boaz to the harvesters who are laboring in his fields (2:4); in the book of Judges, an angel speaks similar words to Gideon (6:12), where they are words of promise: for soon Gideon will lead his oppressed people to victory and freedom. For us, the words become a greeting of peace, a prayer that the Lord will indeed be with us, and a reminder of his promise to be with us always, to the end of the world (Matthew 28:20). Our response—"And also with you," soon to be "And with your spirit"—returns to the presider this prayer for the Lord's presence. As we know from the scriptures, a prayer for the Lord's presence is no small thing, for when God comes in our midst, God brings healing, grace, and challenge. God's presence transforms us.

#### First Reconciliation and First Communion:

**Parents:** It is time to begin preparation for First Reconciliation. Children in second grade and older who have not yet received their First Reconciliation are eligible. First Reconciliation precedes First Communion. If you would like your child to receive the sacraments this year and are ready to aid in their preparation this is the current plan.

Because of the Bishop's new protocols we cannot have classes in house. Therefore, I will give you materials to use in teaching your child(ren). The book is easy to use and there are online videos to supplement. If the Bishop's protocols change then we will have in house class.

First Reconciliation will be in March. We will have First Communion the first weekend in May for those who have completed First Reconciliation.

## **NEW DIOCESAN PROTOCOLS** **EFFECTIVE JAN. 9<sup>TH</sup> thru Feb. 5<sup>th</sup>**

1. We have been instructed to close the office to the public during this time. Someone will be there to answer the phone during normal business hours. For emergencies after hours, you can reach Fr. Mike Martinez at the number given on the recording.
  2. Our Parish has been given permission to continue our Saturday & Sunday weekend Masses. Also, starting on Monday, January 11<sup>th</sup> we will begin daily Mass at NOON in the courtyard. This will be Monday thru Friday. If we have inclement weather the weekday Mass will be cancelled for that day.
  3. Adoration will be suspended until at least Feb. 5<sup>th</sup>.
  4. Funerals & Weddings may be celebrated indoors but limited to 25 people.
  5. Baptisms may be celebrated indoors but limited to 10 people.
  6. There will be no public gatherings on parish grounds for the next 4 weeks other than those described above.
  7. These guidelines are subject to change based upon the effects of the virus. Updates from Bishop Weisenburger are expected no later than Feb. 5<sup>th</sup>.

  - Funerales y bodas se pueden celebrar en el interior de la iglesia, pero serán limitadas a un número máximo de 25 personas.
  - Bautizos se pueden celebrar en el interior de la iglesia, pero serán limitadas a un número máximo de 10 personas.
  - Ningún tipo de reunión pública o celebraciones serán permitidas en la parroquia o en la propiedad de la parroquia. Funerales, bodas, y bautizos se permitirán en acuerdo con las restricciones y guías de la iglesia.
  - Estos protocolos están sujetos a cambiar basados en los efectos del COVID. Mas información se espera del Obispo Weisenburger a más tardar el 5 de Febrero.
