

Your new AZ tax refund increases to:	\$1,339
Your tax credit to CTSO:	-\$1,089

Your AZ tax withholding:	\$1,500

## Examples assume single taxpayer with at least \$1,250 of AZ tax liability.

School Tuition Organizations cannot award, restrict or reserve scholarships solely based on a donor's recommendation.
