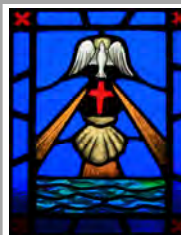
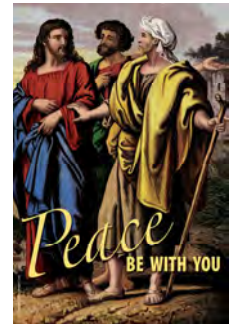

Last week we celebrated Divine Mercy Sunday. When Jesus appeared to St. Faustina He told her, "I demand from you deeds of mercy which are to arise out of love for me. You are to show mercy to your neighbors always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to excuse yourself from it." (Diary 742)

These deeds of mercy are to be accomplished by three means: our actions, our words, and our prayers.

### **THE CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY**

Feed the hungry

Give drink to the thirsty.

Clothe the naked.

Shelter the homeless.

Comfort the imprisoned. (Not all prisons are physical jails.)

Visit the sick.

Bury the dead.

### **THE SPIRITUAL WORKS OF MERCY**

Admonish sinners.

Instruct the uninformed.

Counsel the doubtful.

Comfort the sorrowful.

Be patient with those in error. (When driving don't curse other drivers)

Forgive offenses.

Pray for the living and the dead.

No matter how much we may be hurting and think our own life is troubled, there is always someone worse off who needs an act of mercy from us. One small act can change someone's entire life. As we go about our daily lives we should be looking for opportunities to practice the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. Remember, the best way to get a blessing is to be a blessing to someone else. A blessing only becomes a blessing when you give it away!

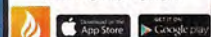
