Concluding Rites

The Prayer after Communion gives us a glimpse of the heavenly banquet, of which we have had a foretaste in the Eucharist. The concluding rites speak of what we are to do with this great gift of God. That includes the parish announcements, which are usually given following the Prayer after Communion. Believe it or not, the announcements, which are not an "official" part of the Mass, have been included in the Mass from as early as the fifth century! The deacon or the homilist-even the bishop-would announce coming liturgical celebrations and encourage the people to participate. Today's parish announcements include opportunities for prayer, service, learning, and community building. They should be succinct and should include only significant events and activities in the life of the parish. But even when they are long and tedious, the announcements (and the parish bulletin) flow out of the concluding rites of the Mass. They offer us ways to live the Eucharist, to become what we have received—the Body of Christ, living and active in our local community. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.





Cochise County Critical Need: Children in Out of Home Care Need Foster Parents

There are many children that have been removed from their homes through absolutely no fault of their own. Unfortunately, there are very few foster homes in Cochise County to accommodate them.

How does this impact?

Very few children that are removed from their homes in Cochise County get to stay here. They are instead transported to "first available," locations all over the state. This increases the trauma that child feels and makes reunification efforts complicated and more difficult.

Who can be a foster parent?

Foster and adoptive parents are normal folks just like yourself. You don't have to be an actual superhero to be a child's hero. There is no singular "ideal" candidate to be a foster parent, having a desire to help the children in our county is a great start.

Does a foster parent receive funds?

Yes, a foster parent receives monthly funds to cover the costs for the children they are supporting.



The **Eucharist** is the human being's ongoing, important encounter with God in which the Lord makes himself our food and gives himself to transform us into him. (Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI Angelus, 29, July 2012)

The person who thinks only of himself says only prayers of petition; the one who thinks of his neighbor says prayers of intercession; whoever thinks only of loving and serving God, says prayers of abandonment to God's Will, and this is the prayer of the saints. The price of this prayer is too high for most people, for it demands the displacement of our ego. 


