# **Cochise County Critical Need: Children in Out of Home Care Need Foster Parents**

*There are many children that have been removed from their homes through absolutely no fault of their own. Unfortunately, there are very few foster homes in Cochise County to accommodate them.*

## **How does this impact?**

Very few children that are removed from their homes in Cochise County get to stay here. They are instead transported to “first available,” locations all over the state. This increases the trauma that child feels and makes reunification efforts complicated and more difficult.

## **Who can be a foster parent?**

Foster and adoptive parents are normal folks just like yourself. You don't have to be an actual superhero to be a child's hero. There is no singular “ideal” candidate to be a foster parent, having a desire to help the children in our county is a great start.

## **Does a foster parent receive funds?**

Yes, a foster parent receives monthly funds to cover the costs for the children they are supporting.
