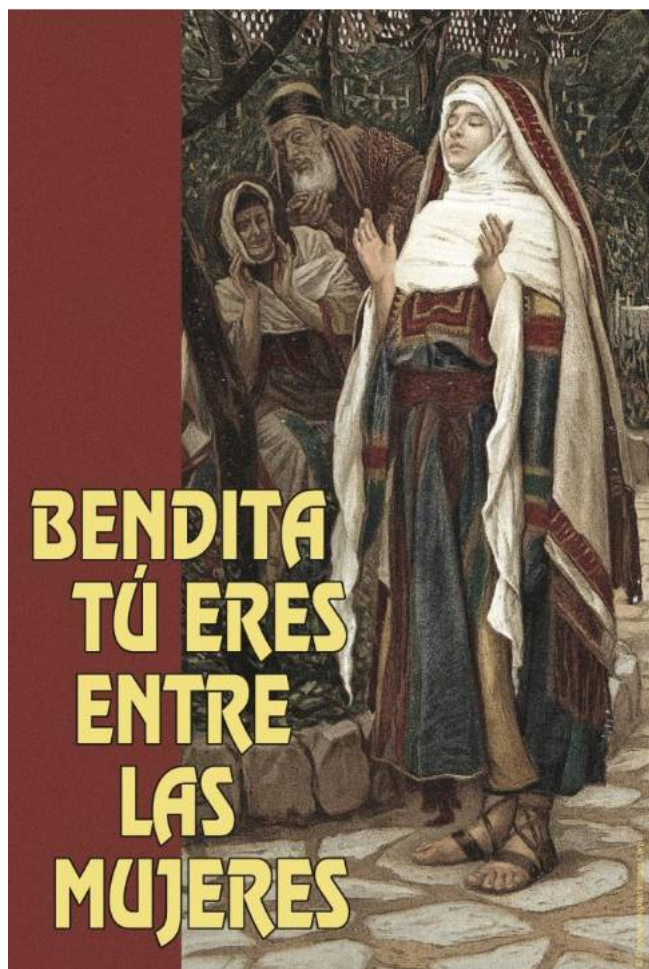
### Council news:

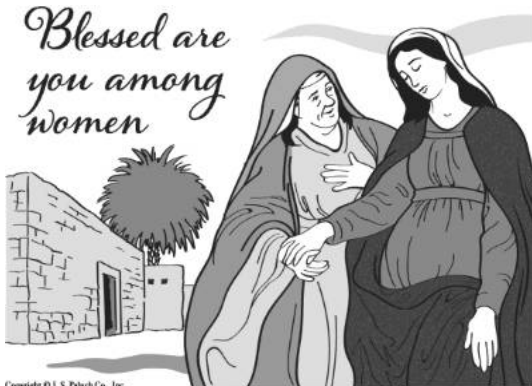
