



WE HAVE GREAT NEWS! The Individual Tax Credit limits have increased.

The amount you can now contribute to **Arizona's Catholic Tuition Support Organization (CTSO)** has increased. If filing as a single taxpayer you can give up to \$1,219, and a married couple filing jointly can contribute up to \$2,435, and you, the donor can receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit off your Arizona tax liability.
