The purpose of the meeting is to give information regarding what the children need to know and to answer any questions you may have.



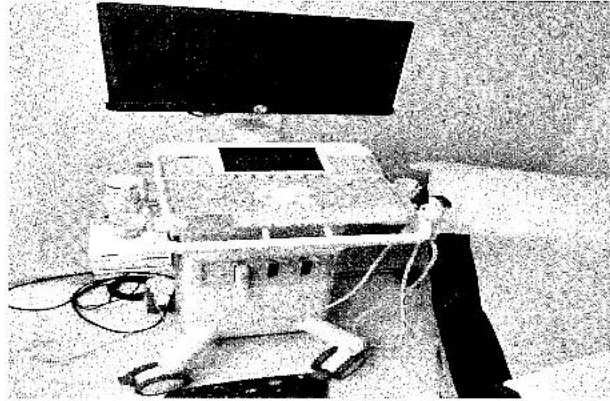
