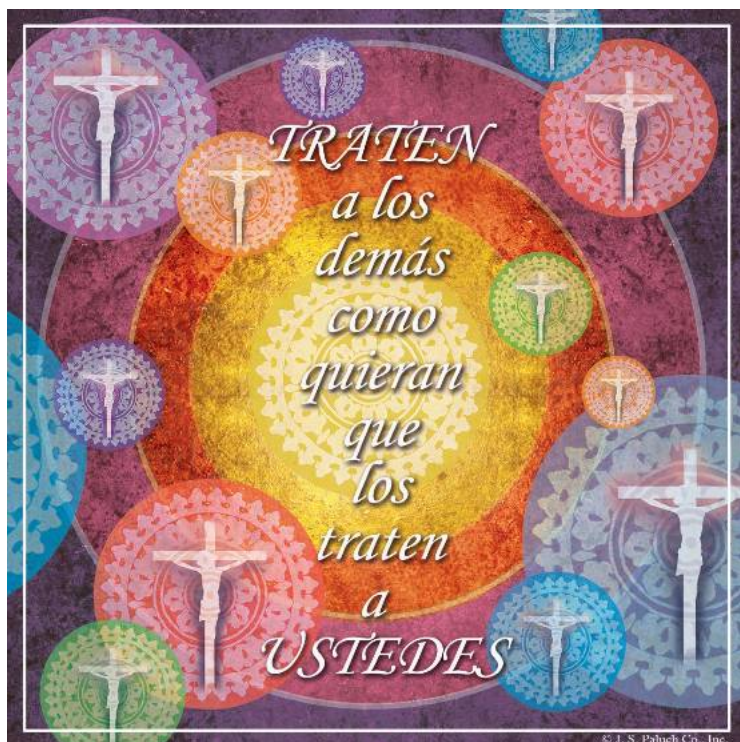

Matthew Kelly has published a new book on generosity and the effect it can have on our lives. It is titled "The Generosity Habit" and Matthew Kelly's suggestion is that this Lent we really try to come to a conversion of heart by examining our generosity habits. Scholarship Opportunity

Going to college or a trade school? Plan on continuing your Catholic Faith journey while you do so? You may be eligible for the St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship Endowment award. The St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship Endowment (SAASE) will award \$1,000.00 scholarships to students from the Sierra Vista area that are enrolled, or are enrolling in an institution of higher learning in 2022/23.

Eligibility: Open to confirmed members of St. Andrew the Apostle Parish in Sierra Vista or another Roman Catholic Church in the greater Sierra Vista area who are enrolled, or are enrolling in an institute of higher learning (community college, post-high school vocational school, technical college, university, etc.). Students need not attend a Catholic institute of higher learning to receive the funds. The recipient must be a Confirmed Catholic in good standing.

How to Apply: To apply - follow the instructions on the checklist below. Fill out and sign the form at the end of this letter and include it with your packet. You will be competing with other candidates for the scholarship. Application packets are also available at the parish offices at St. Andrew the Apostle, Our Lady of the Mountains, Holy Family Catholic Community, and Sacred Heart Catholic Church. An online application form may be emailed to you at your request at thad.a.larson@gmail.com.

Deadline: You may submit your application packet online to thad.a.larson@gmail.com. The deadline for online submissions is **May 6, 2022**. We request that all attachments are done in PDF format. Digital signatures are accepted. All letters of recommendation **MUST** be signed either digitally or physically. Scanning letters of recommendations is acceptable as long as they are in PDF format.

You may also mail your packet. Applications must be postmarked or hand delivered to Thad Larson no later than **May 6, 2022**.

A Quick Questions and Answers Guide to Arizona Tuition Tax Credits

Q. Can I benefit from giving to CTSO?

A1. **Yes, you benefit if you have AZ tax liability.**

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): \$1,250

Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,089

Your new tax payment due to AZ is now only: \$161

A2. **You benefit even if you get a refund.**

Your AZ tax withholding: \$1,500

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): -\$1,250

Your AZ tax refund (what you overpaid): \$250

Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,089

Your new AZ tax refund increases to: \$1,339

Examples assume single taxpayer with at least \$1,250 of AZ tax liability

School Tuition Organizations cannot award, restrict or reserve scholarships solely based on a donor's recommendation. Taxpayers may not claim a tax credit if the taxpayer agrees to swap donations with another taxpayer to benefit either taxpayer's own dependent. See your tax professional for guidance.

Q. What if I don't yet know if I have any Arizona Tax liability for 2021?

A. **To get an idea, check your 2020 taxes.**
