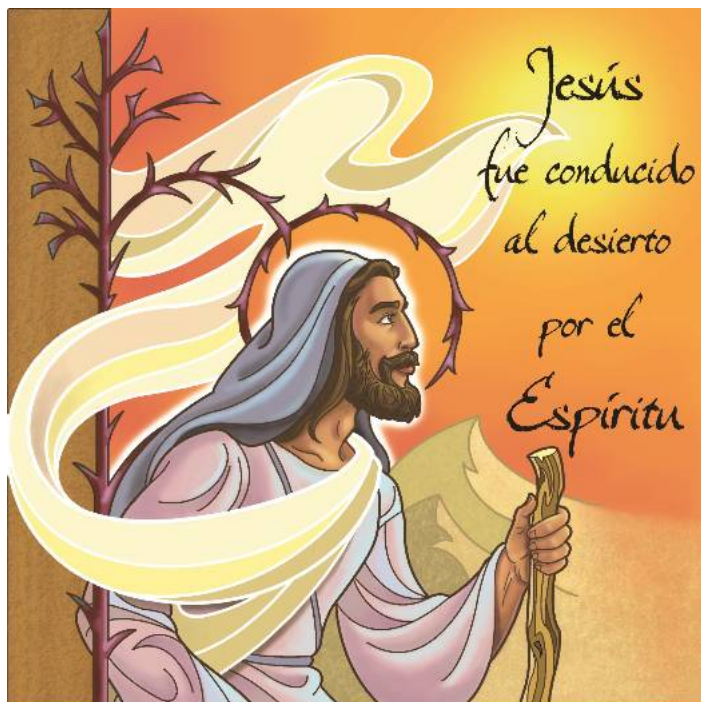

Happy Lent!!

The key to understanding the meaning of Lent is Baptism. Preparation for Baptism and for renewing baptismal commitment lies at the heart of the season. Since Vatican II, the Church has reemphasized the baptismal character of Lent.

Why is Baptism so important to understanding Lent? Lent as a forty day season developed in the fourth century. There were 3 sources that came together at that time to make the forty days of Lent that we now know. First was the ancient paschal fast that began as a two day observance before Easter but was lengthened to forty days over time. The second was the catechumenate (RCIA) as preparation for Baptism which included an intense period of preparation for the sacraments of initiation to be celebrated at Easter. The third was the Order of Penitents, which sought a second conversion for those who had fallen back into serious sin after Baptism and was modeled after the catechumenate. As the catechumens (those preparing for Baptism) entered their final period of preparation the penitents and the rest of the community accompanied them on their journey and prepared to renew their Baptismal vows at Easter. So then Lent is baptismal in its nature. How well are you living out your baptismal vocation as priest, prophet, king? How could you grow in your spiritual life this Lent?

Generosity tip #10

Scholarship Opportunity

Going to college or a trade school? Plan on continuing your Catholic Faith journey while you do so? You may be eligible for the St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship Endowment award. The St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship Endowment (SAASE) will award \$1,000.00 scholarships to students from the Sierra Vista area that are enrolled, or are enrolling in an institution of higher learning in 2022/23.

Eligibility: Open to confirmed members of St. Andrew the Apostle Parish in Sierra Vista or another Roman Catholic Church in the greater Sierra Vista area who are enrolled, or are enrolling in an institute of higher learning (community college, post-high school vocational school, technical college, university, etc.). Students need not attend a Catholic institute of higher learning to receive the funds. The recipient must be a Confirmed Catholic in good standing.

How to Apply: To apply - follow the instructions on the checklist below. Fill out and sign the form at the end of this letter and include it with your packet. You will be competing with other candidates for the scholarship. Application packets are also available at the parish offices at St. Andrew the Apostle, Our Lady of the Mountains, Holy Family Catholic Community, and Sacred Heart Catholic Church. An online application form may be emailed to you at your request at thad.a.larson@gmail.com.

Deadline: You may submit your application packet online to thad.a.larson@gmail.com. The deadline for online submissions is **May 6, 2022**. We request that all attachments are done in PDF format. Digital signatures are accepted. All letters of recommendation MUST be signed either digitally or physically. Scanning letters of recommendations is acceptable as long as they are in PDF format.

You may also mail your packet. Applications must be postmarked or hand delivered to Thad Larson no later than **May 6, 2022**.

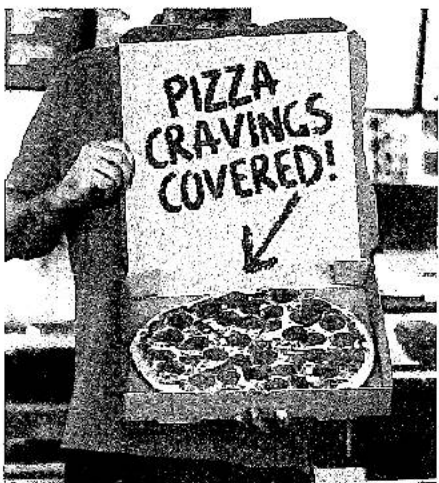

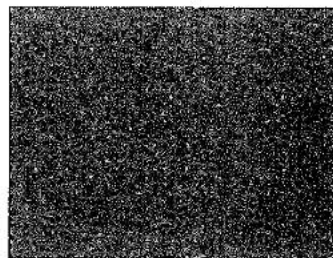
