

Scholarship Opportunity

Going to college or a trade school? Plan on continuing your Catholic Faith journey while you do so? You may be eligible for the St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship Endowment award. The St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship Endowment (SAASE) will award \$1,000.00 scholarships to students from the Sierra Vista area that are enrolled, or are enrolling in an institution of higher learning in 2022/23.

Eligibility: Open to confirmed members of St. Andrew the Apostle Parish in Sierra Vista or another Roman Catholic Church in the greater Sierra Vista area who are enrolled, or are enrolling in an institute of higher learning (community college, post-high school vocational school, technical college, university, etc.). Students need not attend a Catholic institute of higher learning to receive the funds. The recipient must be a Confirmed Catholic in good standing.

How to Apply: To apply - follow the instructions on the checklist below. Fill out and sign the form at the end of this letter and include it with your packet. You will be competing with other candidates for the scholarship. Deadline: You may submit your application packet online to thad.a.larson@gmail.com. The deadline for online submissions is **May 6, 2022**. We request that all attachments are done in PDF format. Digital signatures are accepted. All letters of recommendation MUST be signed either digitally or physically. Scanning letters of recommendations is acceptable as long as they are in PDF format.

"Organ donation is a unique testimony of charity. There exists, in fact, a responsibility of love and charity that commits oneself to make one's own life a gift for others, if one truly seeks one's own fulfillment. The act of love, which expressed with the **gift of one's own vital organs**, is a genuine testimony of charity that knows how to look beyond death so that life always wins."

Saint Pope John Paul II

For a New Culture of Human Life - (March 25, 1995)

"Over and above such outstanding moments, there is an everyday heroism, made up of gestures of sharing, big and small, which build up an authentic culture of life. A particularly praise worthy example of such gestures is the donation of organs,...with a view to offering the chance of health and even life to sick who sometimes have no hope."

Facts about Organ and Tissue Donation

FACT: It's a federal crime to buy or sell organs and tissues. Race, gender, income or celebrity status are never considered in determining who receives an organ. Organ allocation is based on factors including blood type, length of time on a waiting list, geographical location, severity of illness or other medical criteria.

FACT: Doctors who treat patients at the time of death have nothing to do with donation or transplantation of their organs and tissues. Every effort is made to save the patient's life before donation can be considered.

FACT: There is no cost to be a donor. Donation is a gift. Any costs for transplantation are the recipient's cost.

FACT: Studies show that donation most often provides immediate and long-term consolation.
