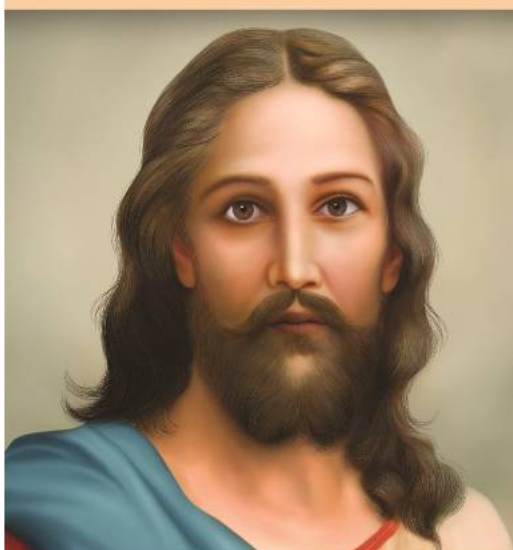

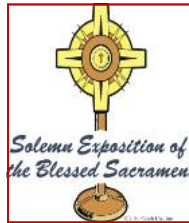

Report of 2022 AZ State KofC Council Annual Drawing to Support Local Charities

Our Lady of the Mountains (OLM) Knights of Columbus (KofC) Council 10799 collected \$3,545.00 thru the generosity of the Council Knights and the Holy Family/OLM Parishioners towards this worthy effort. The Council added \$55.00 to the amount collected to round up the total to \$3,600.00. A check for the total amount (\$3,600.00) was provided to the AZ State Council on the morning of 20 May 2022 at the AZ KofC Annual State Convention.

OLM will receive one half of the amount we collected or \$1,800.00 back and in addition since we collected 10% more than last year, OLM will receive an additional \$180.00. 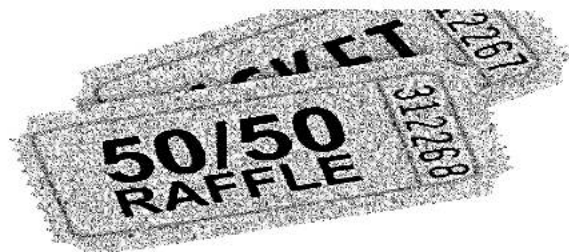
