Establishing a lights out and even an electronics out policy will help them. They need 8 hours to fully allow their body and mind to relax and grow. (2) Although breakfast menus have changed, the more complete their breakfast, the more attentive they are at school. (3) Like all members of the family, they need to feel safe, loved, heard and supported. Their emotional needs are just as real as our own and appreciably affects their ability and desire to learn. A positive, loving family environment goes a long way in enhancing a true sense of self-motivation. (4) Children who read are at a huge advantage intellectually. They have a better vocabulary, language and conversational skills, concentration, problem solving abilities, understanding of concepts, memory, listening skills, imagination, emotional maturity to list a few. Exposing our children to different types of books and reading a bedtime story will produce phenomenal results. They will develop an enjoyment for reading even when it comes in the form of homework."

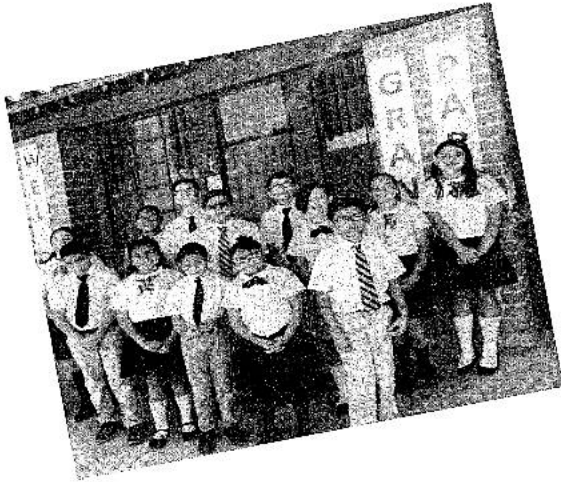
