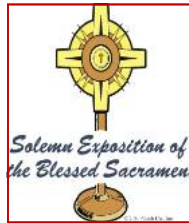

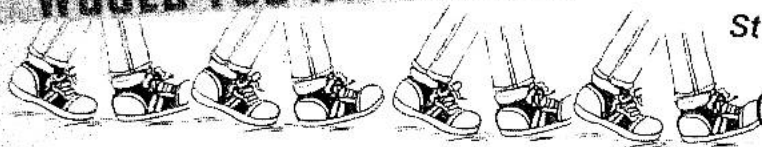
Marriage Tip of the Week

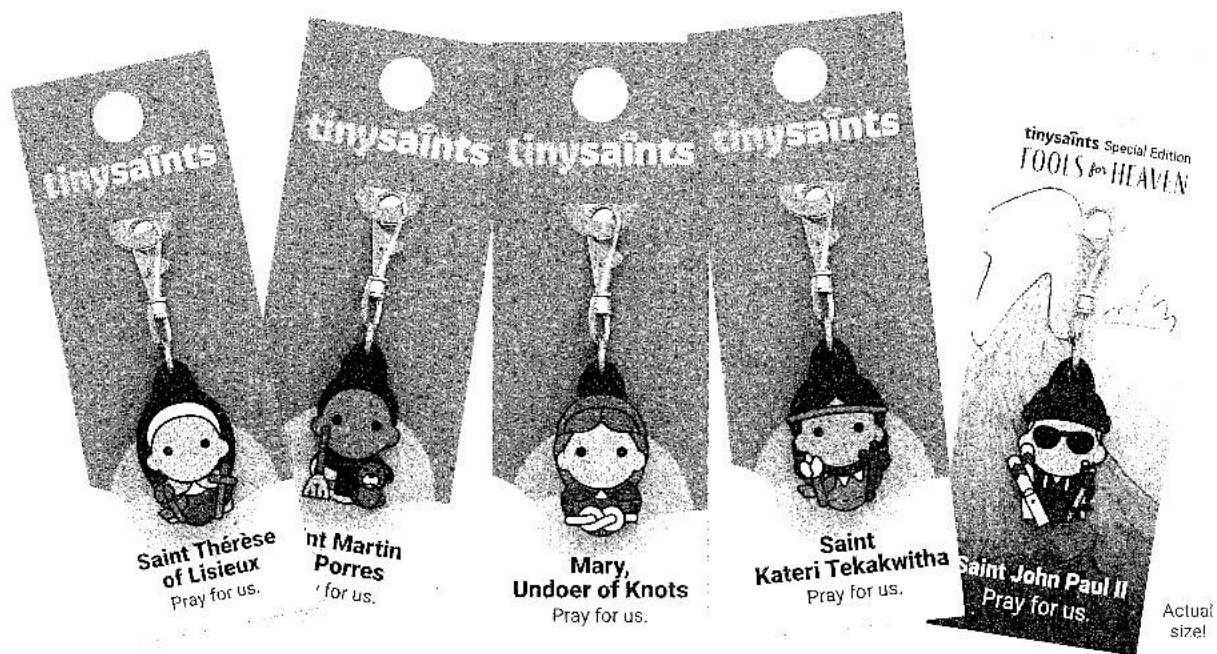
