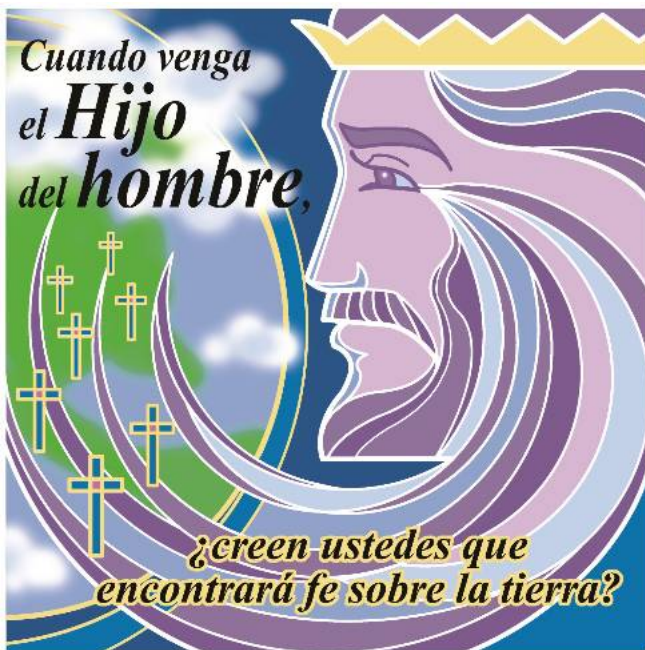

Open enrollment is ongoing for the new school year. Currently we have 102 students enrolled for this year. There are still openings in grades 1-8. School Masses will be every Thursday at 8:00am. You may also check us out on Facebook!

"The recent US Department of Education annual report indicated the largest score drop in reading among 9-year-old students since 1990. Numerous studies by universities and parent organizations have consistently emphasized the critical need for parents and schools to maintain a very active reading program starting with kindergarten students. The connection between reading abilities and future academic success in high school and college is unequivocal. Our All Saints School places great emphasis on reading starting Day 1 of school in all grades. Parents and grandparents can participate and accelerate their loved ones learning process by reading to them or having them read out loud."

OLM BOARD OF DIRECTORS: There is an opening for the secretary of the Board of Directors for Our Lady of the Mountains starting January 1, 2023. There are normally two board meetings each year based on information from the parish Finance Council. Position requires the person to coordinate with the Pastor and the parish Business Manager and the diocese Corporate Matters financial analyst. 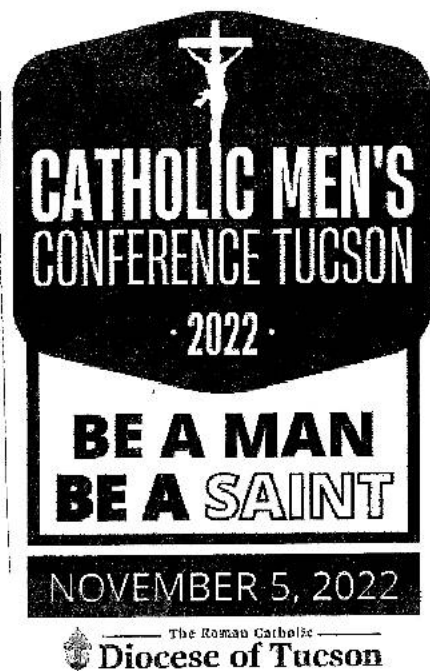

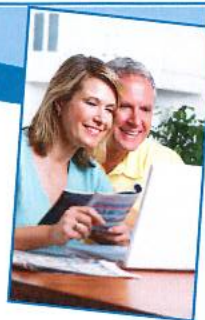
