There are two (2) non-perishable dates: **Nov 5 & 6** and **Nov 12 & 13**. (The perishable collection date is 19 & 20 November.)

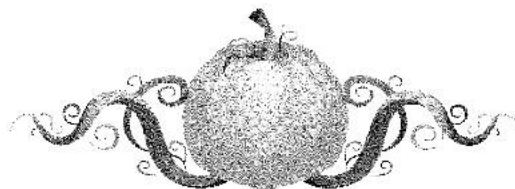

- **Frozen Turkey (we have storage!)**

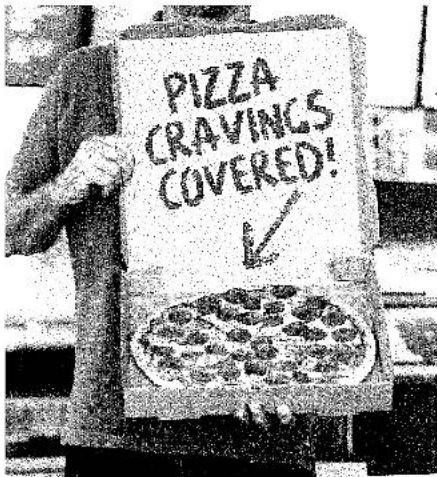

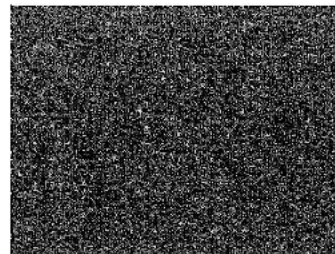

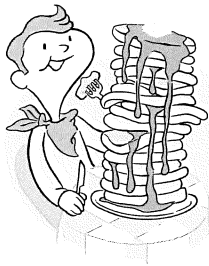
