

Our Need to Change

Thursday, December 8 is a Holyday of Obligation. Masses are at 8:00 am and 5:30 pm

A feast called the Conception of Mary arose in the Eastern Church in the seventh century. It came to the West in the eighth century. In the eleventh century, it received its present name, The Immaculate Conception. In the eighteenth century it became a feast of the universal church.

In 1854, Pius IX solemnly proclaimed: "The most Blessed Virgin Mary, in the first instant of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege granted by almighty God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the savior of the human race, was preserved free from all stain of original sin."

It took a long time for this doctrine to develop. While many fathers and doctors of the church considered Mary the greatest and holiest of the saints, they often had difficulty seeing Mary as sinless; either at her conception or throughout her life. This is one of the church teachings that arose more from the piety of the faithful than from the insights of brilliant theologians. Two Franciscans, William of Ware and Blessed John Duns Scotus, helped develop the theology. They point out that Mary's Immaculate Conception enhances Jesus' redemptive work. Other members of the human race are cleansed from original sin after birth. In Mary, Jesus' work was so powerful as to prevent original sin at the outset.

OLM BOARD OF DIRECTORS: There is an opening for the secretary of the Board of Directors for Our Lady of the Mountains starting January 1, 2023. There are normally two board meetings each year based on information from the parish Finance Council. Position requires the person to coordinate with the Pastor and the parish Business Manager and the diocese Corporate Matters financial analyst. If you are interested in running for this position, you must be at least 25 years of age, a registered parishioner in good standing, and a practicing Catholic. You may pick up a standard nomination form in the Parish Office or in the back of church and return it by the close of business Friday, December 9th, with 5 signatures of registered parishioners. The election will be held on the weekend of December 17th and 18th.

OUR FASCINATING FAITH

The Season of Advent

What are we really waiting for during Advent? The longstanding tradition of the Church is that the Advent season really marks not one but three comings of Christ: his coming into history two thousand years ago, his coming in glory at the end of time, and his coming into our hearts here and now. Advent starts with a focus on the future coming of Christ so that we might see the big picture. If Christmas is to make any sense at all, we have to ask the guestion, "What are you doing to get ready for the (final) coming of Christ?" This perspective opens us up to the sense of anticipation experienced by the Jewish people on the eve of the first coming of Christ. This Advent, we will hear John the Baptist tell them (and us) how best to prepare. He urges repentance and an examination and reform of our way of life. Then on the Fourth Sunday, we are drawn in to the history of Jesus' arrival as the child of Joseph and Mary. Our work of spiritual preparation brings us to the point of the whole season. What good is it that Christ comes into my heart if I don't then carry that presence out into the world, just as Mary did?
