


Next Week's Gospel Preparation 3rd Sunday in Lent, John 4:5-42 Source of Strength March 12

Happy Lent!!

The key to understanding the meaning of Lent is Baptism. Preparation for Baptism and for renewing baptismal commitment lies at the heart of the season. Since Vatican II, the Church has reemphasized the baptismal character of Lent.

Why is Baptism so important to understanding Lent? Lent as a forty day season developed in the fourth century. There were 3 sources that came together at that time to make the forty days of Lent that we now know. First was the ancient paschal fast that began as a two day observance before Easter but was lengthened to forty days over time. The second was the catechumenate (RCIA) as preparation for Baptism which included an intense period of preparation for the sacraments of initiation to be celebrated at Easter. The third was the Order of Penitents, which sought a second conversion for those who had fallen back into serious sin after Baptism and was modeled after the catechumenate. As the catechumens (those preparing for Baptism) entered their final period of preparation the penitents and the rest of the community accompanied them on their journey and prepared to renew their Baptismal vows at Easter. So then Lent is baptismal in its nature. How well are you living out your baptismal vocation as priest, prophet, king? How could you grow in your spiritual life this Lent?

There will be no Religious Education classes on March 15 and no Confirmation classes on March 13 during Spring break.
