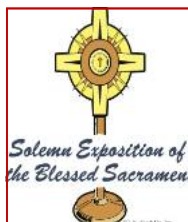

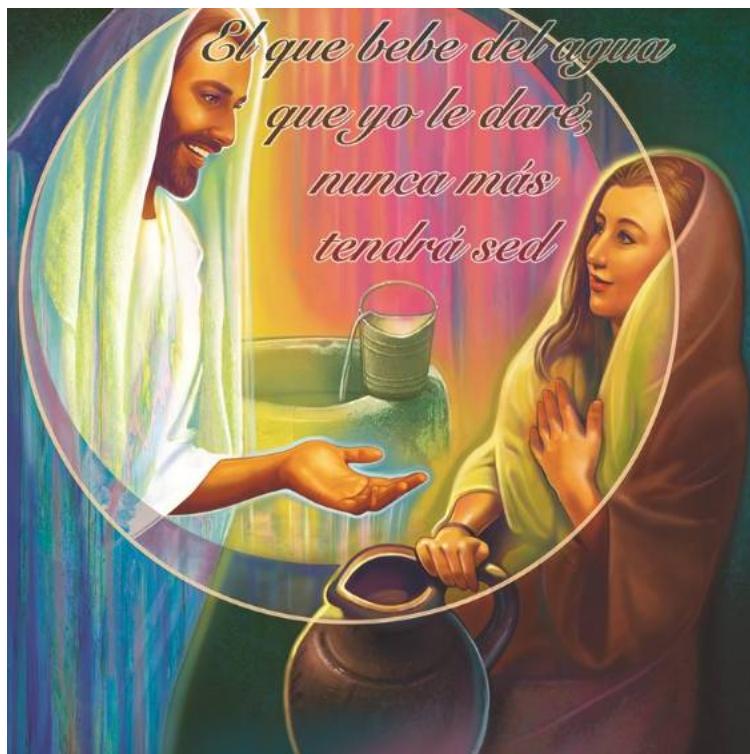
## **Marriage Tip**
