





Feast of Divine Mercy: Sunday, April 16, 2023

OLM's Mercy Sunday Celebration

2:15-3:15pm Eucharistic Adoration & Divine Mercy Chaplet

"Turn to my mercy"... words spoken by Jesus in private revelations to a simple, humble nun, Sr. Mary Faustina Kowalska, during the 1930's in Poland. As an uneducated, sickly nun, she humbly performed her convent chores of cook, gardener, and gatekeeper. She had frequent mystical experiences during which Jesus invited her to announce anew the gospel message of God's mercy.

Jesus requested His desire that His Divine Mercy be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. "On that day I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon souls who approach the fount of mercy." In preparation for the Feast of Divine Mercy, Jesus requested confession, communion and a novena of prayers beginning Good Friday and ending on the Feast. "You will recite it for nine days on the beads of the rosary.." "On each day you will bring to my heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of my mercy. On each day you beg my father for the strength of my bitter passion, for graces for these souls."

Reciting the Divine Mercy Chaplet

Our Lord taught Sister Faustina a prayer for mercy that she was to pray "unceasingly." We too can pray this chaplet, using ordinary rosary beads of the five decades. We begin with the Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostles Creed.

On the bead before each decade, pray: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Souls and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world. On the "Hail Mary" beads, pray: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. After five decades, pray 3 times: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

The Novena of the Divine Mercy

First Day

Today bring to Me all mankind, especially all sinners, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, whose very nature it is to have compassion on us and to forgive us, do not look upon our sins but upon our trust which we place in Your infinite goodness. Receive us all into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart, and never let us escape from It. We beg this of You by Your love which unites You to the Father and the Holy Spirit.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon all mankind and especially upon poor sinners, all enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion show us Your mercy, that we may praise the omnipotence of Your mercy for ever and ever. Amen

Second Day

Today bring to Me the souls of priests and religious, and immerse them in My unfathomable mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, from whom comes all that is good, increase Your grace in men and women consecrated to Your service, that they may perform worthy works of mercy; and that all who see them, may glorify the Father of Mercy who is in heaven.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the company of chosen ones in Your vineyard—upon the souls of priests and religious; and endow them with the strength of your blessing. For the love of the Heart of Your Son in which they are enfolded, impact to them Your power and light, that they may be able to guide others in the way of salvation and with one voice sing praise to Your boundless mercy for ages without end. Amen.

Third Day

Today bring to Me all devout and faithful souls, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, from the treasury of Your mercy, You impart your graces in great abundance to each and all. Receive us into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart and never let us escape from It. We beg this grace of You by that most wonderous love for the heavenly Father with which Your Heart burns so fiercely. Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon faithful souls, as upon the inheritance of Your Son. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, grant them Your blessing and surround them with Your constant protection. Thus may they never fail in love or lose the treasure of the holy faith, but rather, with all the hosts of Angels & Saints, may they glorify Your boundless mercy for endless ages. Amen.

Fourth Day

Today bring to Me those who do not believe in God and those who do not yet know Me.

Most compassionate Jesus, You are the Light of the whole world. Receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who do not believe in God and of those who as yet do not know You. Let the rays of Your grace enlighten them that they, too, together with us, may extol Your wonderful mercy; and do not let them escape from the abode which is Your Most Compassionate Heart. Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls of those who do not believe in You, and of those who as yet do not know You, but who are enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. Draw them to the light of the Gospel. These souls do not know what great happiness it is to love You. Grant that they, too, may extol the generosity of Your mercy for endless ages. Amen.

Fifth Day

Today bring to Me the souls of those who have separated themselves from the Church.

Most Merciful Jesus, Goodness Itself, You do not refuse light to those who seek it of You. Receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who have separated themselves from Your Church, Draw them by Your light into the unity of the Church, and do not let them escape from the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart; but bring it about that they, too, come to glorify the generosity of Your mercy. 
Ninth Day

A Quick Questions and Answers Guide to Arizona Tuition Tax Credits

Q. Can I benefit from giving to CTSO?

A1. Yes, you benefit if you have AZ tax liability.

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill):	\$1,250
Your tax gedit to CTSO;	\$1,089
Your new tax payment due to AZ is now only:	\$161

A2. You benefit even if you get a refund.

Your new AZ tax refund increases to:	\$1,339
Your tax credit to CTSO:	-\$1,089
Your AZ tax refund (what you overpaid):	\$250
Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill):	-\$1,250
Your AZ tax withholding:	\$1,500

Examples assume single toxpayer with at least \$1,250 of AZ tax liability.

School Tuition Organizations cannot award, restrict or reserve scholarships solely based on a dozor's recommendation. Texpayers may not claim a tax credit if the texpayer agrees to swap donations with another texpayer to benefit either texpayer's own dependent. See your tax professional for guidance.


