



A Reflection for Good Shepherd Sunday

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is also known as "Good Shepherd Sunday."

In the Gospel, Jesus states, "I am the good shepherd and I know my sheep and mine know me." This implies a relationship that is much more than moral codes and religious rituals. Jesus is calling us to a deep, intimate relationship, in which we know and hear his voice, and this is reciprocal.

There is an Old Song "Do You Know Your Shepherd's Voice?" This is the chorus:

"Do you know your Shepherd's voice? Are you list'ning with your heart? Have you stopped to hear Him calling? Felt the peace His words impart? As the world shouts it's orders that are easiest to hear won't you draw away and listen to your Shepherd?" (text and music by Susan Lord) Worth contemplating and it's on you tube if you would like to listen.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Going to college or a trade school? Plan on continuing your Catholic Faith journey while you do so? You may be eligible for the St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship Endowment award. The St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship Endowment (SAASE) will award \$1,000.00 scholarships to students from the Sierra Vista area that are enrolled or are enrolling in an institution of higher learning in 2023/24.

Eligibility: Open to confirmed members of St. Andrew the Apostle Parish in Sierra Vista or another Roman Catholic Church in the greater Sierra Vista area who are enrolled or are enrolling in an institute of higher learning (community college, post-high school vocational school, technical college, university, etc.).
