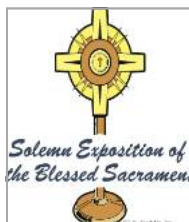

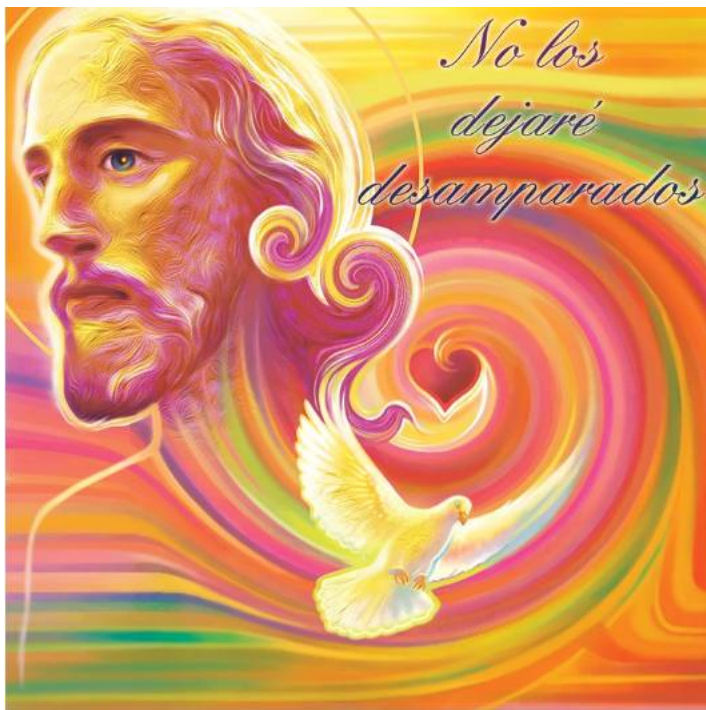

When you're upset or feeling blue.

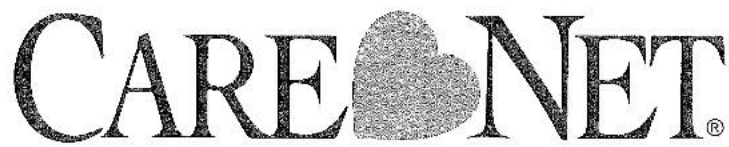
