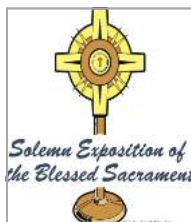

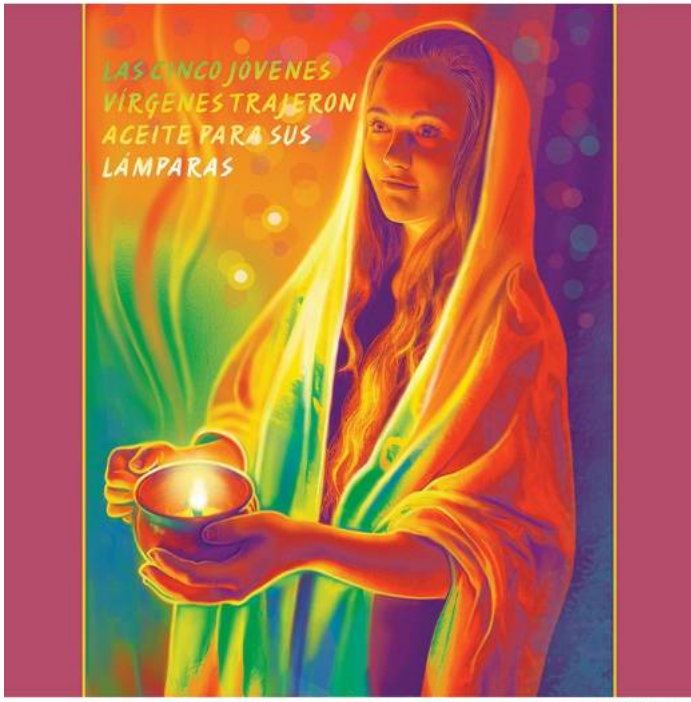
Christmas Books

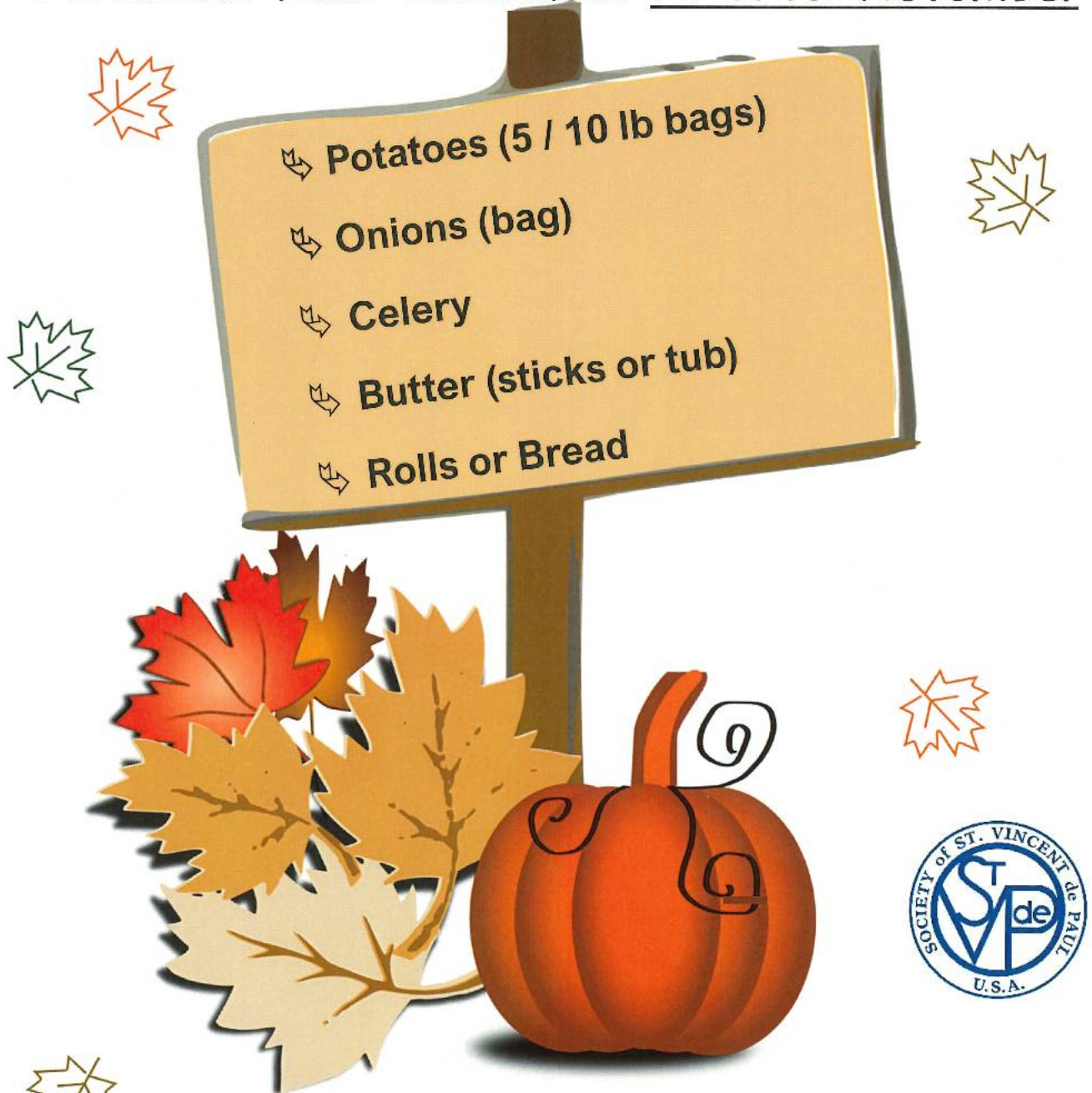
