All Saints Catholic School School News!

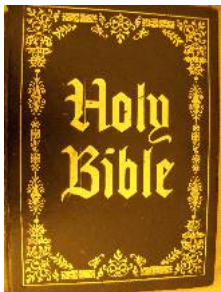

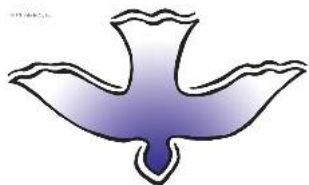

We celebrate Martin Luther King, Jr and all he stood for tomorrow. It is worth remembering what he lived for and ultimately died for.

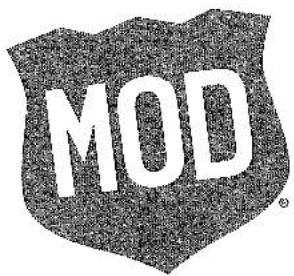
