



Fr. Kino Scholarship Packet (Formally known as the St. Andrew the Apostle Scholarship)

The total available funds for the scholarship may be divided among an appropriate number of recipients as determined by the committee, or awarded to a single individual as circumstances dictate.

We request that all attachments are done in PDF format. Digital signatures are accepted. All letters of recommendation MUST be signed either digitally or physically. You may also mail your packet. Applications must be postmarked or hand delivered to Thad Larson no later than **May 17, 2024**.






