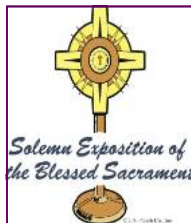

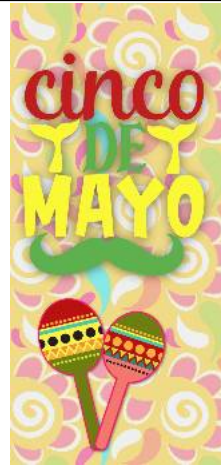

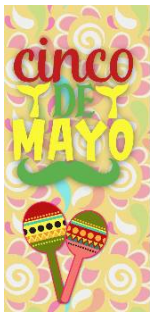

While ASCS offers teachers appreciable smaller class sizes, more discipline and respect, it does not make up for a smaller salary. Therefore, if any individual would like to have a very lasting, dynamic impact on the quality of education some 100 plus students get at ASCS, they are asked to contact Principal Carmen Rosado at 520-378-7012 as to how they can use God's abundant gifts to help his children. Any size donation will help ASCS acquire qualified teachers while precluding burn-out of those teachers on staff.
