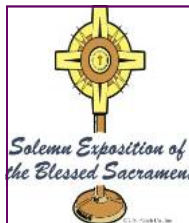

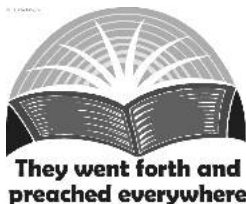

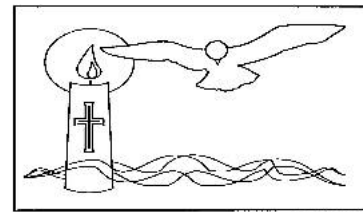

I will be that number you can call for anything,

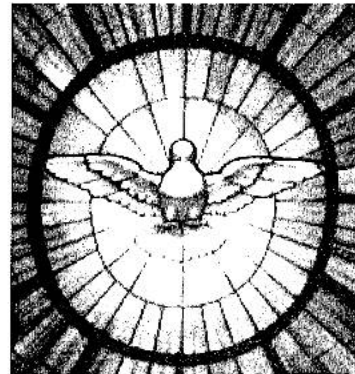
No matter what the cost.
