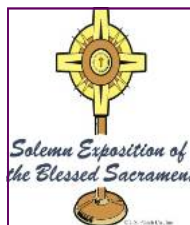

and celebrate once again

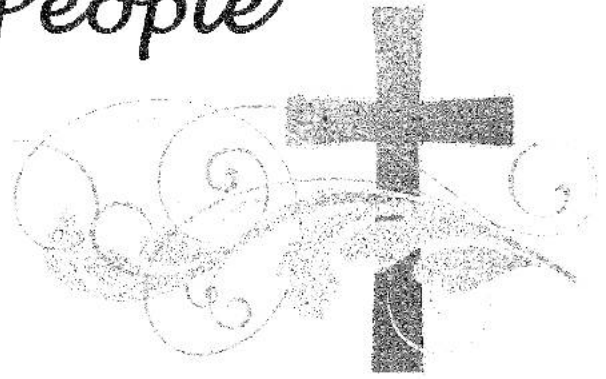
the memory of that first Pentecost,

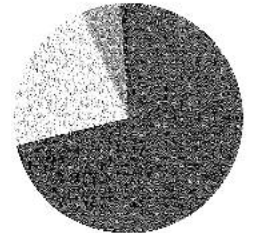
