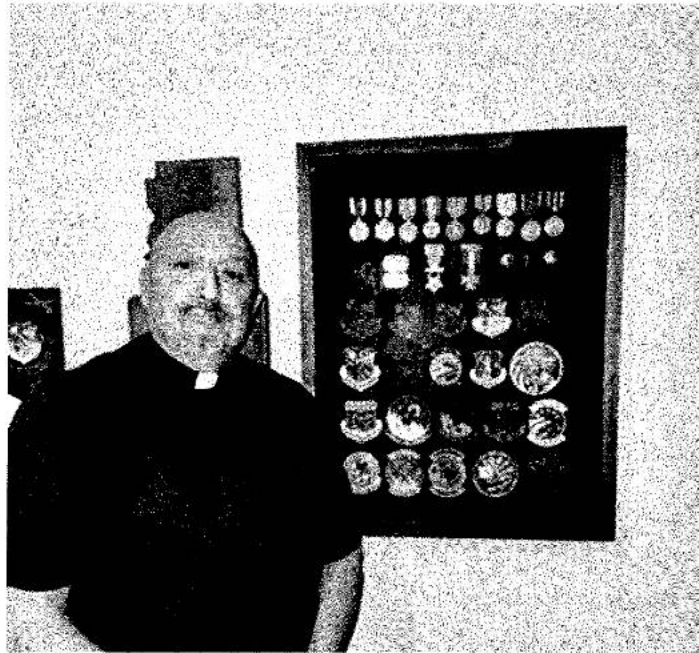
Confirmation classes for students in grades 9 and up will begin on August 26 at 5:30 pm.
