# SUPPORT THE WORKS OF THE HOLY FATHER THROUGH THE Peter's Pence Collection Be a sign of

Urkey and Syria are situated in a region that experiences frequent, major earthquakes. In early February 2023, central Turkey's most powerful earthquake since 1939 struck with a magnitude of 7.8. More than 10,000 aftershocks continued for weeks afterward, including a powerful magnitude 6.4 aftershock that struck the biblical city of Antioch, known as Antakya. More than 50,000 people in Turkey and neighboring Syria were killed by the initial earthquake, followed by more deaths and the destruction of structures damaged by the first earthquake. UN officials estimated that more than 1.5 million people were left homeless in what is believed to be the largest natural disaster in Turkey's history.

In a mid-February meeting with Turkey's new ambassador to the Holy See, Pope Francis asked what sort of aid Turkey most needed. Within 24 hours, Cardinal Konrad Krajewski, the papal almoner and prefect of the Vatican's Dicastery for the Service of Charity, organized a shipment of canned food, diapers, thermal garments, and other necessities, to be sent from Rome to a warehouse in Turkey for distribution to those in need. At the same time, economic aid to Syrian victims was entrusted to the apostolic nunciature in Syria. In addition to this material relief, the Vatican's prefect for the Dicastery for the Eastern Churches, Archbishop Claudio Gugerotti, visited Syria and Turkey to provide a ministry of presence to victims.

The Holy Father's charitable outreach to victims of war, migrants and refugees, the poor, and those affected by illness and natural disasters is supported by your contributions to the Peter's Pence Collection. # Colecta Peter's Pence Sea un signo de

Urquía y Siria están situadas en una región que frecuentemente sufre de fuertes terremotos. A principios de febrero del 2023, el terremoto más fuerte desde 1939 azotó la región central de Turquía con una magnitud 7.8. Hubo más de 10,000 réplicas, las cuales continuaron por semanas después, incluyendo un fuerte terremoto con una magnitud de 6.4 que azotó la ciudad bíblica de Antioquía, conocida como Antakya. A causa del primer terremoto, más de 50,000 personas fallecieron en Turquía y en la vecina Siria y, más adelante, hubo más muertes y destrucción de las estructuras dañadas por el primer terremoto. Funcionarios de las Naciones Unidas estimaron que más de 1.5 millones de personas perdieron sus viviendas en lo que se cree fue el más grande desastre natural en la historia de Turquía.

A mediados de febrero, en una reunión con el nuevo embajador de Turquía ante la Santa Sede, el papa Francisco le preguntó qué tipo de ayuda era la más necesaria en Turquía. Dentro de las siguientes 24 horas, el cardenal Konrad Krajewski, limosnero y prefecto del Dicasterio para el Servicio de la Caridad, organizó un cargamento de comida enlatada, pañales, ropa térmica y otras necesidades, para que fuese enviado desde Roma a un depósito en Turquía y ser distribuido entre los más necesitados. Al mismo tiempo, a la nunciatura apostólica en Siria se le encomendó proporcionar ayuda económica a las víctimas sirias. Aparte de esta ayuda material, el prefecto del Dicasterio para las Iglesias Orientales del Vaticano, arzobispo Claudio Gugerotti, visitó Siria y Turquía con el fin de proporcionar un ministerio de presencia a las víctimas.

El alcance caritativo del Santo Padre a las víctimas de guerra, a los migrantes y refugiados y a los pobres afectados por enfermedades y desastres naturales es financiado por las contribuciones a la Colecta Peter's Pence. Cuando ustedes participan en la colecta, se unen a los católicos en todo el mundo al apoyar la misión de misericordia del Papa y las acrividades de los dicasterios de la Santa Sede que lo asisten en su ministerio.

## **OLM Building Maintenance Fund**

#### Hello OLM Family,

There has been some construction activity happening at the parish hall, as we are sure you have noticed. There has been an internal water leak caused by the drain spout [scupper] at the north east corner of the Parish hall building [men's bathroom area]. This has been happening over quite some time and finally seen back in February when mold appeared on the interior bathroom wall. Immediately started the process of repair and found the damage was more extensive for inhouse repairs. We contacted several construction companies for bids. Perrill Construction Company was hired to do the job. The crew did an excellent job repairing the building.

We would like to thank you all for your contribution to our Building Maintenance fund. With your continued donations we were able to use these funds to cover the cost (\$22,380.62) of the project, to tear out and replace with new framing, stucco and roofing.
