SUPPORT THE Solidarity Fund for the CHURCH IN AFRICA

When you think of the life of the Church in dioceses and parishes, the first ideas that come to mind might be evangelization efforts, catechesis programs, sacramental preparation for families, or support for seminaries and religious communities that encourage young people to discern vocations as priests or religious sisters or brothers. While such faith-strengthening pastoral ministries are among the visible ways the Church carries out its mission to prepare Christian disciples, the Church also needs responsible administration of parish and diocesan resources. A solid foundation in financial management and recordkeeping helps pastors build trust in the local church and use limited financial resources with transparency and responsibility.

Recognizing this need, the Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa supports episcopal conferences' efforts to train pastors, administrators, and financial staff in budgeting, management, and procedures to improve transparency and accountability. A Solidarity Fund grant to the National Episcopal Conference of Cameroon helped the Diocese of Ngaoundere train 136 members of 29 parish councils in these skills, empowering them to manage financial matters with competence and reliability. The Solidarity Fund also granted funds to the National Episcopal Conference of Congo (in the Democratic Republic of Congo) to conduct financial management training for 121 diocesan and parish staff from the Diocese of Buta. Through this training, the diocese has prepared diocesan clergy and parish staff to manage development projects, social ministries, and parish resources, thereby becoming better and more effective ministers to those they serve.

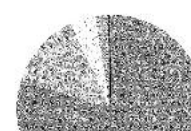

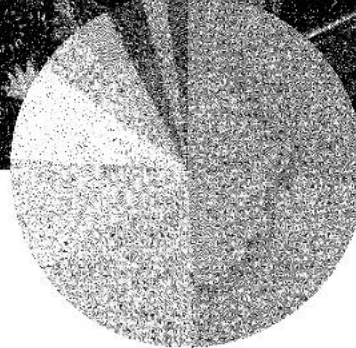

APOYE AL FONDO DE SOLIDARIDAD PARA LA IGLESIA EN AFRICA

Cuando ustedes piensan en la vida de la Iglesia en los diócesis y parroquias, quizás lo primero que se les viene a la mente sean los esfuerzos de evangelización, los programas de catequesis, la preparación sacramental para las familias, o el apoyo que les brindamos a los seminarios y a las comunidades religiosas que animan a los jóvenes a discernir su vocación como sacerdotes o como hermanas o hermanos religiosos. Si bien estos ministerios pastorales que fortalecen la fe se encuentran entre las maneras visibles en las que la Iglesia lleva a cabo su misión para preparar discípulos cristianos, la Iglesia necesita también una administración responsable de los recursos parroquiales y diocesanos. Una base sólida en la administración financiera y en el mantenimiento de registros contables le es de mucha utilidad al párroco para generar confianza en la iglesia local y utilizar los limitados recursos financieros con transparencia y responsabilidad.

Tomando en cuenta esta necesidad, el Fondo de Solidaridad para la Iglesia en África apoya la labor de las conferencias episcopales para capacitar a los párrocos, administradores y personal financiero en la preparación de presupuestos, en la administración y procedimientos para mejorar la transparencia y la rendición de cuentas. Una subvención del Fondo de Solidaridad a la Conferencia Nacional de Obispos de Camerún, ayudó a la Diócesis de Ngaoundéré a capacitar en estas habilidades a 136 miembros de 29 concejos parroquiales, empoderándolos para administrar asuntos financieros con competencia y fiabilidad. El Fondo de Solidaridad también otorgó subvenciones a la Conferencia de Obispos del Congo (en la República Democrática del Congo) para llevar a cabo una capacitación en gestión financiera dirigida a 121 miembros del personal parroquial y diocesano de la Diócesis de Buta. Mediante esta capacitación, la diócesis ha preparado al clero diocesano y al personal parroquial para gestionar proyectos de
