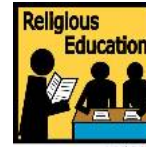
**(Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)**

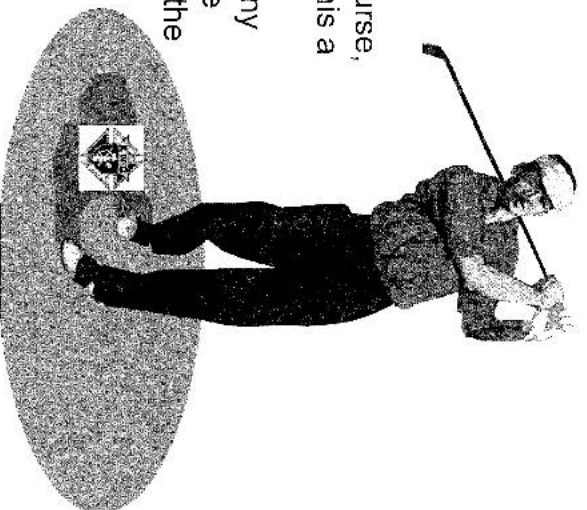

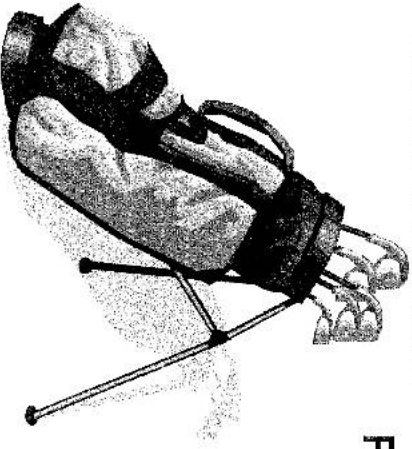
