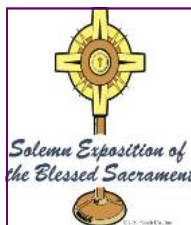

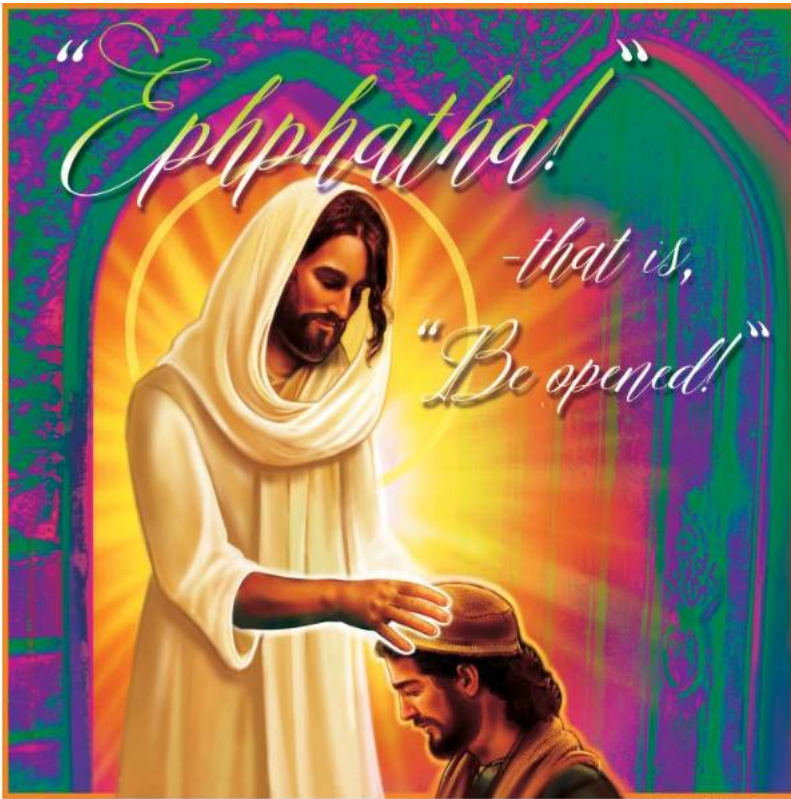

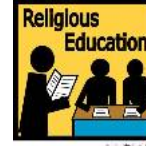
KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS PARISH PANCAKE BREAKFAST

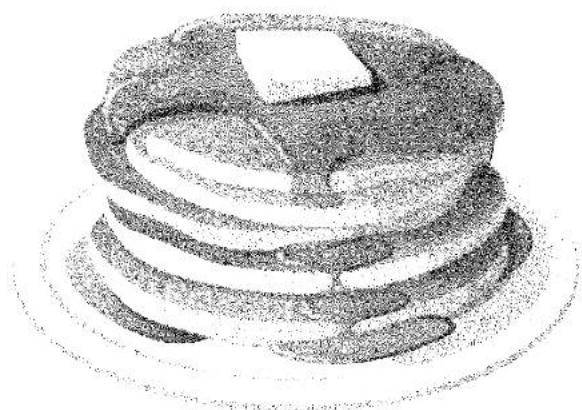

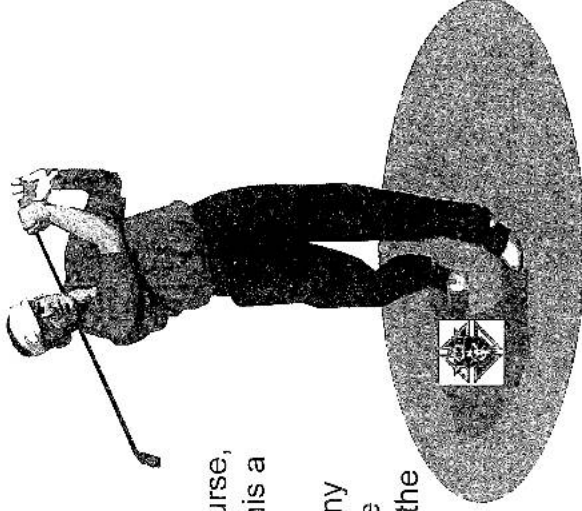

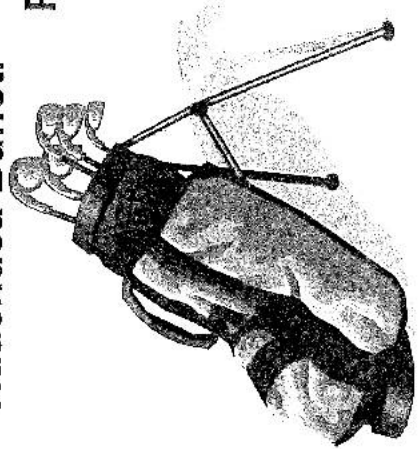
