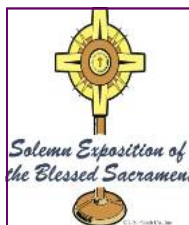

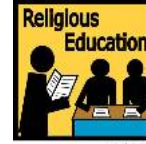
All Saints Catholic School School News!

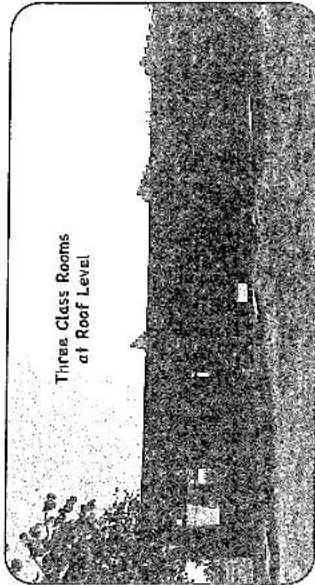

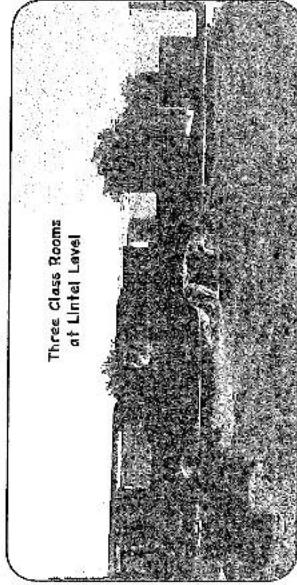

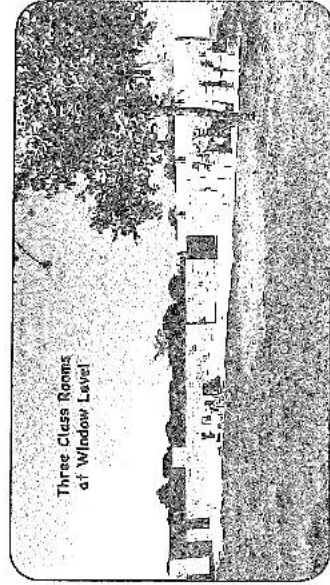
St. Francis de Sales Primary School - Work in Progress

1. Primary School:

The project currently in progress and in need of your generous support for its completion is a Primary School in Zambia. The school has 9 class rooms, including 1 computer room and 1 staff room. Currently the required amount to complete the remaining work of the school building is **\$45,000**. However, urgently we need **\$30,000** to complete 6 class rooms for the immediate use next year. Besides we are also looking for assistance for the furniture of the same school and the cost for the furniture for each class room is estimated to be **\$3000** (40 chairs and desks in each class room, 1 white board, teachers' table - desk and cupboard). 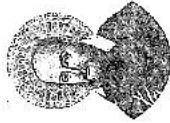

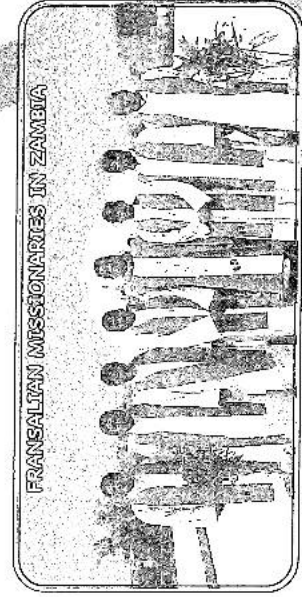
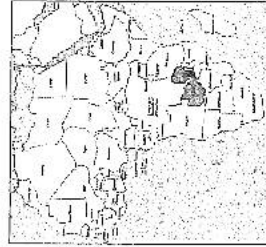
WHO ARE THE MSFS/FRANSALIANS?
