Sep 27: Feast day of St. Vincent de Paul

Many of you know the name "St. Vincent de Paul" as a Thrift Store, but do you know about OLM's SVdP conference? No? Then come, take a walk through a (mostly) typical month with a Vincentian

First Tuesday, at 6:30 a.m., we join volunteers on Hwy 92, south of Ramsey Rd., where we meet an 18-wheeler from "Feed America." Each delivery is a mystery: from canned goods to pasta...to dog food or sunscreen! The goods are taken to OLM', sorted and stored for Rita's Pantry.

First Tuesday of each month, at 4:00 p.m.: The first of two monthly meetings as Vincentians gather to share and grow spiritually. We reflect on ways to build a more just service to our friends in need. Resources, requests, deeds and plans are captured in the approximate 90-minute meeting.

Weeks one and three are designated as "Home Visit" preparation and scheduling weeks. Is it a utility shut off? Rental assistance? Or simply needing food. Help is just a phone call away.

We ask what more can we do? Do we "hear" what the friend really wants or needs from us? Someone who will listen? Someone who will recognize me, my situation, or my problems? To accept me? To help me to help myself?

Rita's Pantry takes place on the 3rd Saturday of the month. On these Saturday mornings, the line forms well before our opening @ 7;30, where we will serve 35-50 families. This has happened for the last 7 years!

Throughout these years a community has formed: where tears and fears are shared, where hope and support are equally provided alongside the food and recycled items.

The second member meeting occurs on the 3rd Tuesday. Each meeting includes prayer, spiritual reflection, and a spirit of fraternity as we address the mission founded by St. Vincent: "Go to the poor: you will find God."

The SVdP office is open on weeks 2 and 4. Each Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, from 9:00 to 11:00, two or more Vincentians are available to help friends who stop by, track of conference activity and maintain an "on site" pantry for food requests.

Each friend we serve has the same God-the-Father that you have. Each friend has the face of Christ hidden among the dirt and grime, the clutter, the desperation caused by poor decisions, deprivation, tyranny of the moment, lost income, lost relationships with family, friends, and GOD.

Vincentians walk deep into this mire with our hearts open...kind and gentle; hands held with God as to extend HIS hand through ours to our friend.

Our friend comes again with wants; just as I come again to Christ—with hands open to partake and receive His love and to share it with each other.

We do not give to receive, yet when we love, we are loved in return by God.
Through each other and the poor, we are renewed. Thank you for walking through
the month with us and sharing the many cups of water given on our journey.
We welcome you...Please, come walk with US.


ZAMBIA MISSION - AFRICA



to continue this liberative mission of Christ effectively in Zambia - Africa on our own without your help will be extremely difficult and impossible. Therefore, we humbly request your








