





On November 21 the Church celebrates World Day of Cloistered Life, an ecclesial event for all Catholics to commemorate the hidden lives of cloistered and monastic religious. Because this school was founded by our own *Fr. Amal Sebastiar* during his six years as a Missionary in rural Zambia, the three Parishes (*Our Lady of the Mountains, St. Patrick's, Bisbee and St. Andrew's*) chose to share a Mission Project to raise \$30,000 to complete nine classrooms. Each Parish was to raise \$10,000 toward the Zambia School Project, hopefully by All Saints' Day (1 November)!

Each Parish exceeded their goal and the <u>total</u> donated is \$52,500! Fr. Amal says that this marvelous shared effort of the three Parishes will now make possible the <u>furnishing</u> of the nine classrooms, with the necessary desks, chairs, and other equipment!

Fr. Amal shared the following: "I have no words to express my joy and appreciation at the generosity and the accomplishment by the parishioners of the three Parishes! Thanks to your awesome efforts and generosity. . . this project which is a tangible expression of your love for the Universal Church particularly for the less privileged brothers and sisters of our family in Zambia. . .!"

Fr. Amal hopes to be present at the Dedication of the School in January and the placement of a plaque on the building acknowledging the generosity of three Parishes!




PASTORAL COUNCIL NEWS
