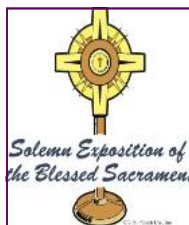

FINDING GOD

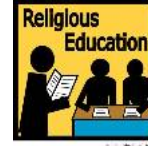

The Magi brought gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh which were gifts deemed fit for a king. What gifts can we give to honor Jesus?

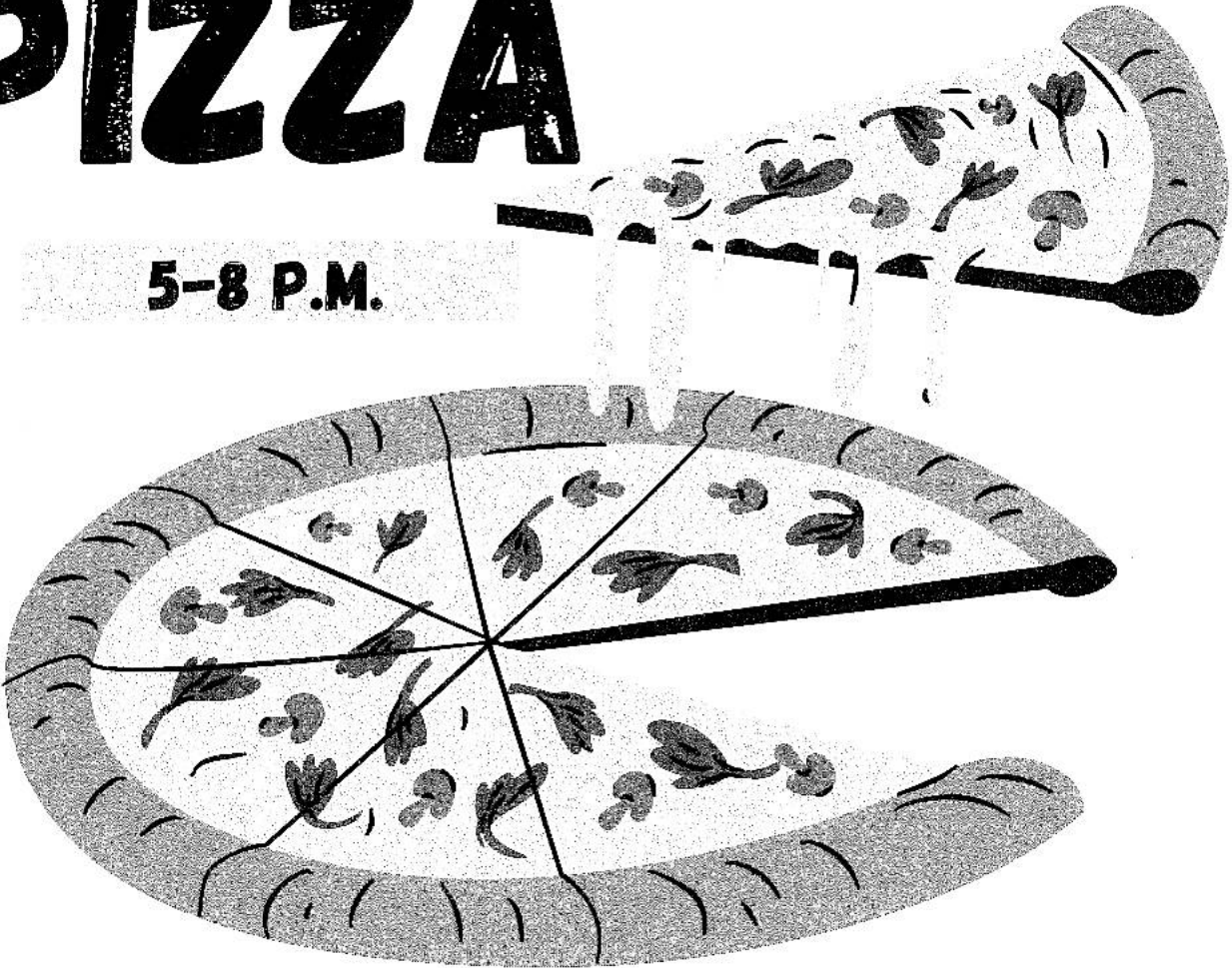
