1. Interior detachment from all sin
2. Sacrament of Reconciliation
3. Holy Communion
4. Prayer for the intentions of the pope (The Our Father and Hail Mary is suggested)

### **THERE ARE DIFFERENT WAYS TO RECEIVE AN INDULGENCE:**

1. Visit and pray at a Pilgrimage Site
2. Perform a work of mercy or penance
3. Recitation of the Our Father, the Profession of Faith and the Rosary (If you are homebound and cannot participate in pilgrimage)
