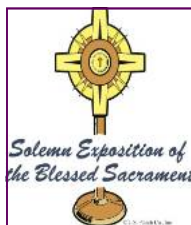

SOUP NIGHTS ON FRIDAYS DURING LENT

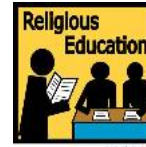
Starting Friday, March 7th soup night will be held in the

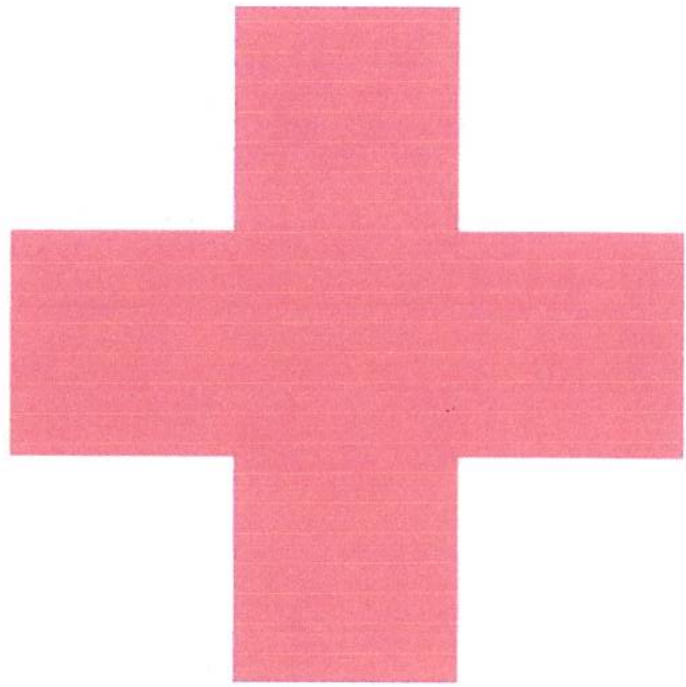

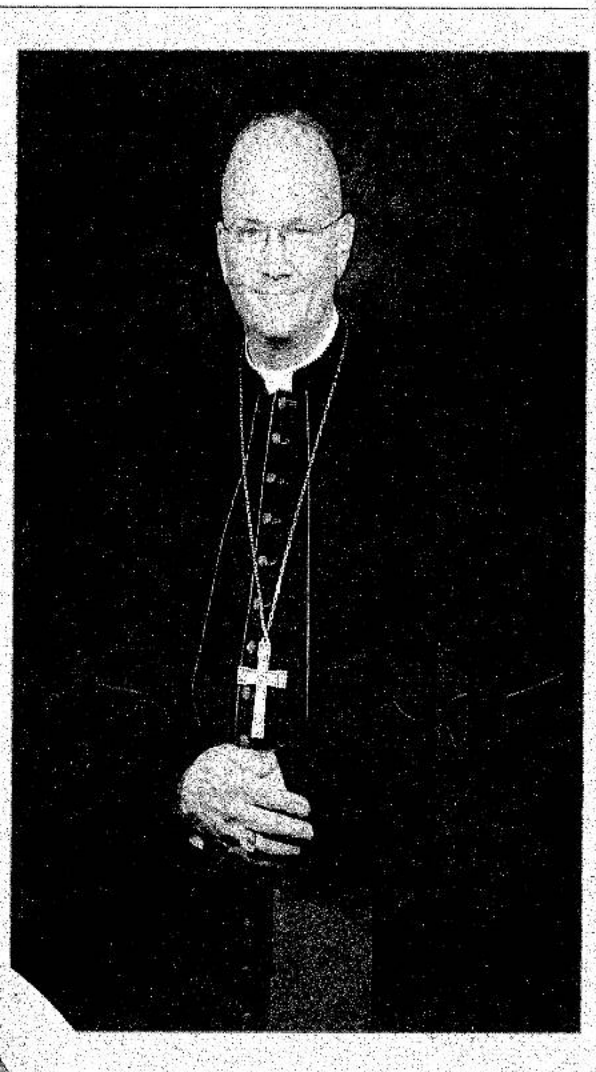
